



An instant native hedgerow is proposed along the eastern boundary to establish a green linear feature to Danson Park and the neighbouring property.



A 1.8 metre high contemporary fence line is proposed around the garden to provide security. This will be a fitting backdrop to the various character areas of the garden.

The existing hedgerow will be retained around the site and enhanced where appropriate. The hedgerow provides a variety of benefits including landscape, visual and ecological interest.

The shrub planting border is located in front of the fence to allow for easy access for maintenance and repair.

The shrub planting border is scattered with amenity trees and large specimen shrubs to provide height and structure to the boundaries.
