212 people with a learning disability filled in a form



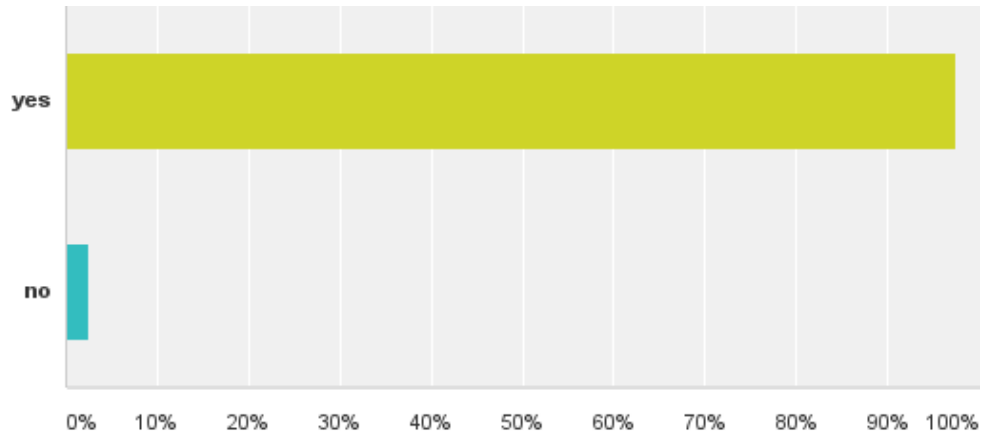

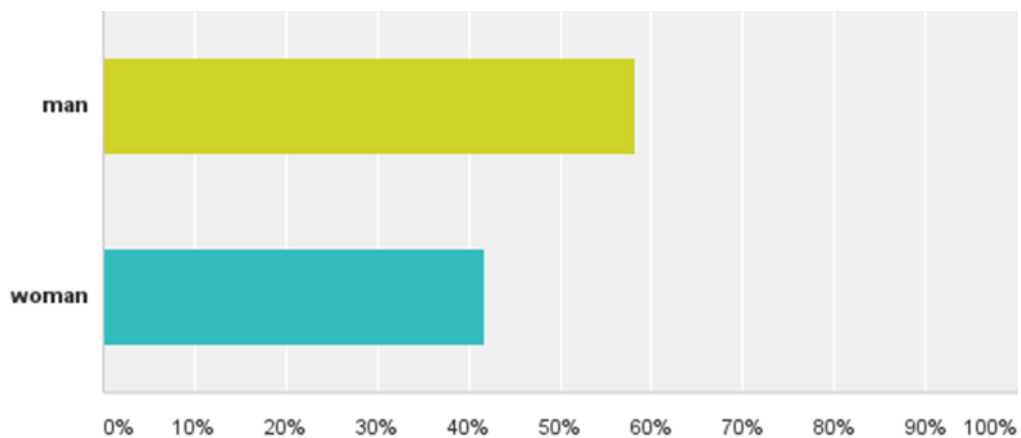

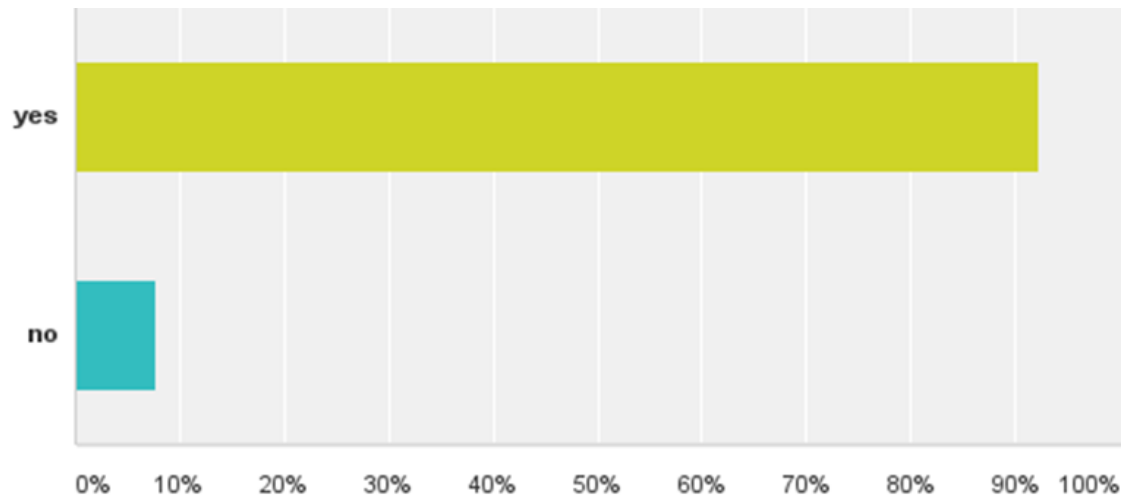

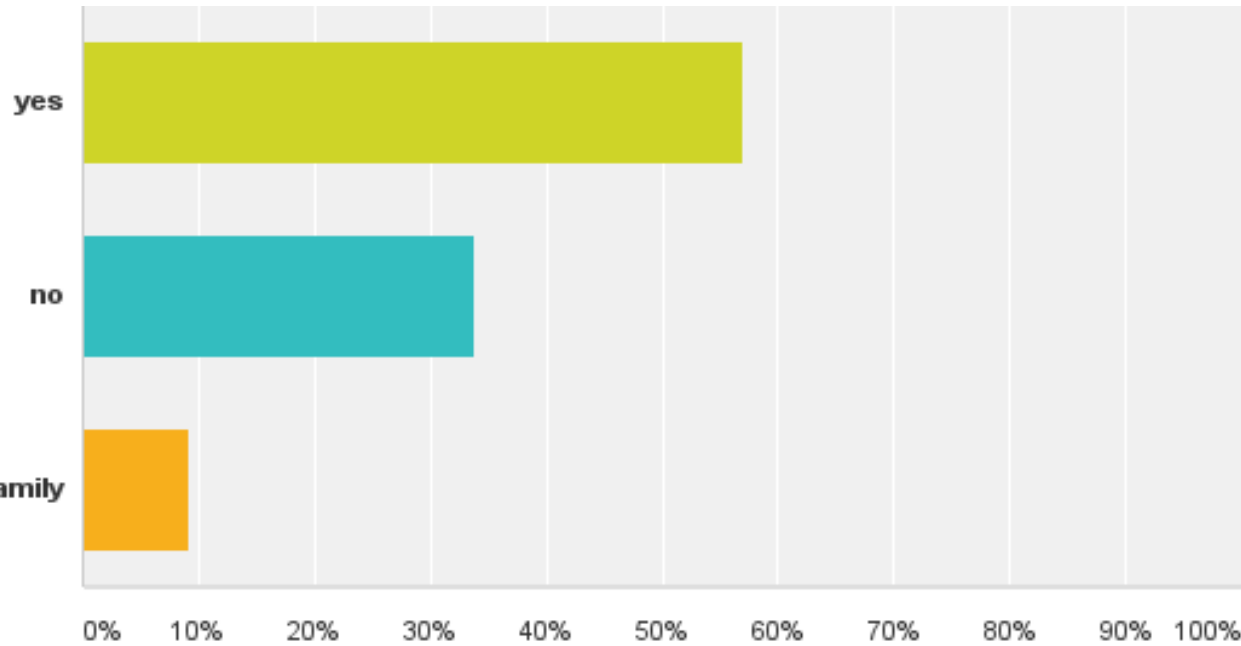
I live in a home that is right for me

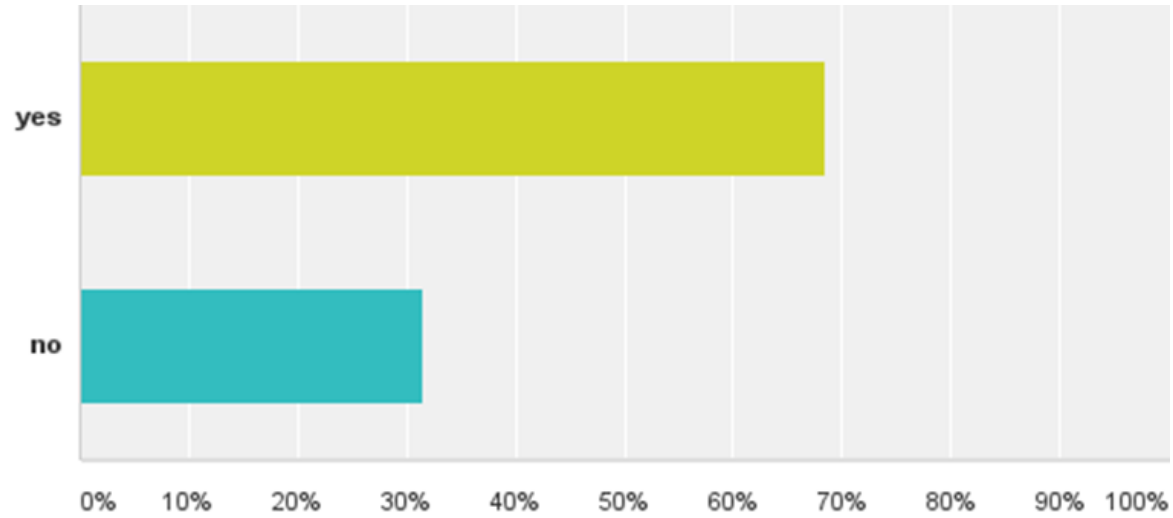

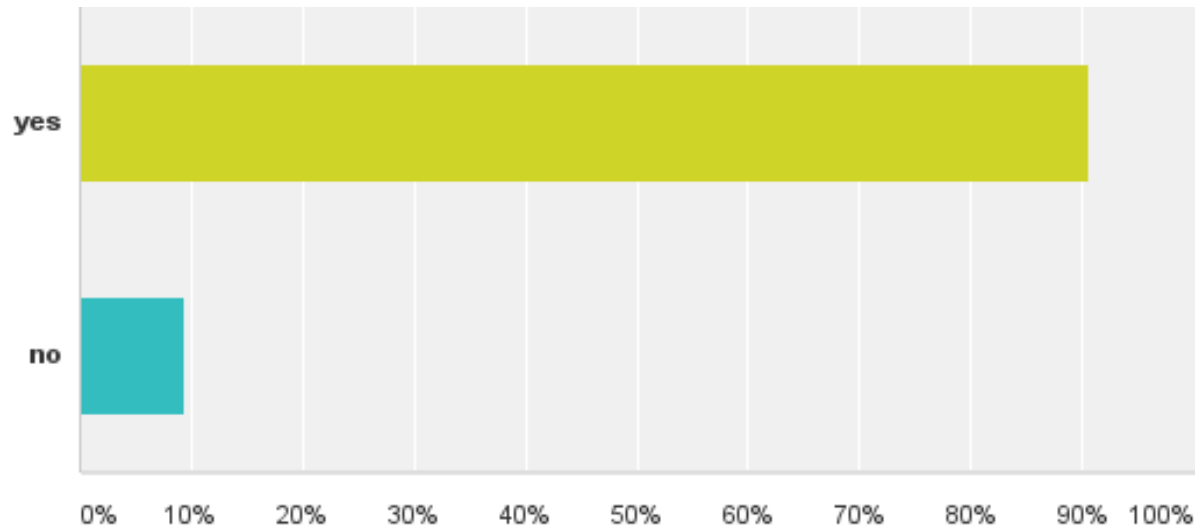
I am involved in activities in the community

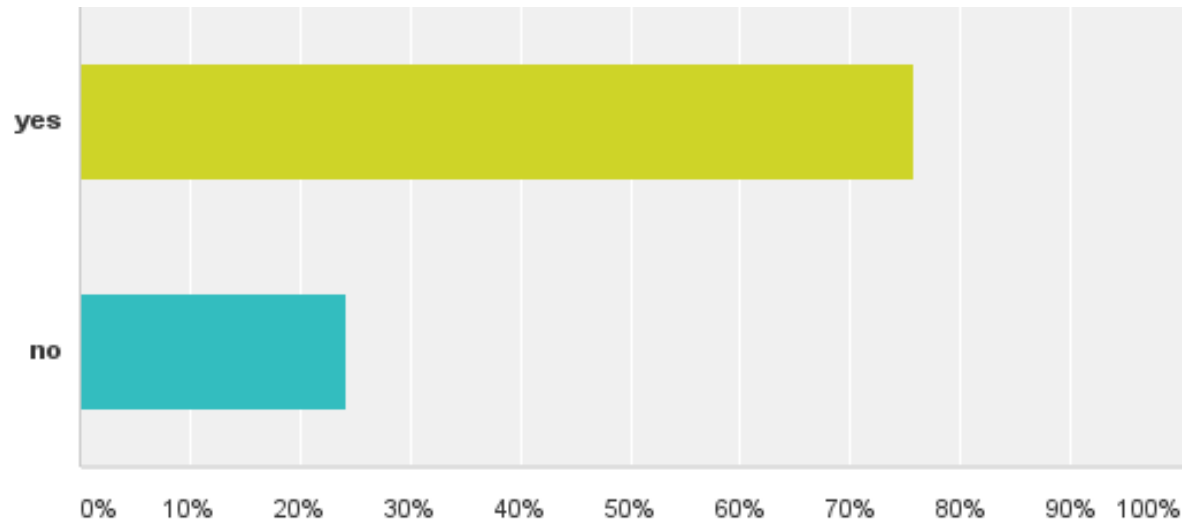
I get good care from all health services

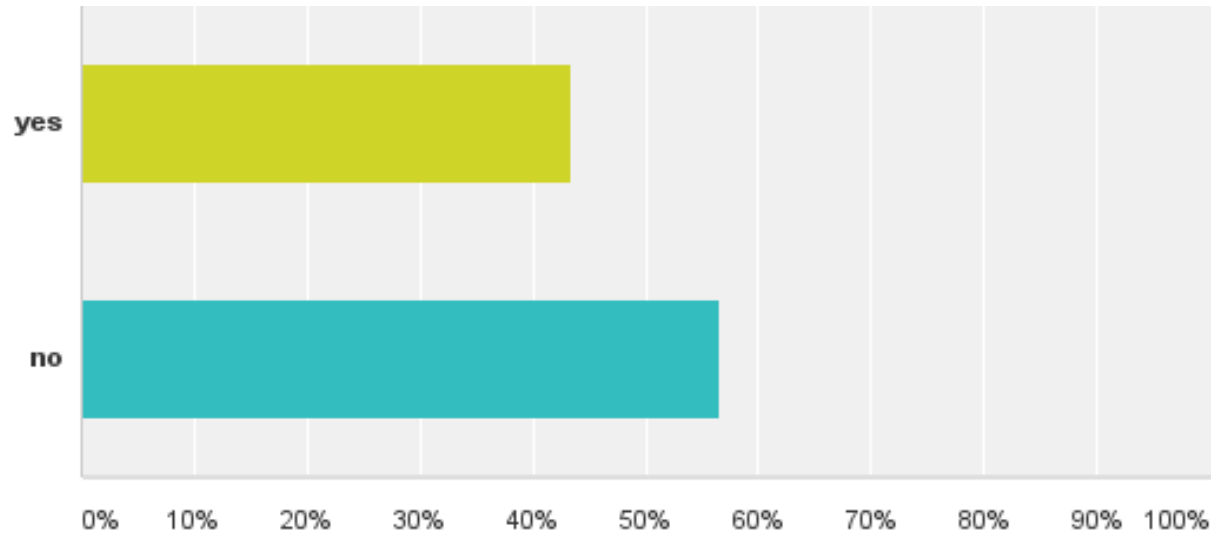
I get help to learn new things

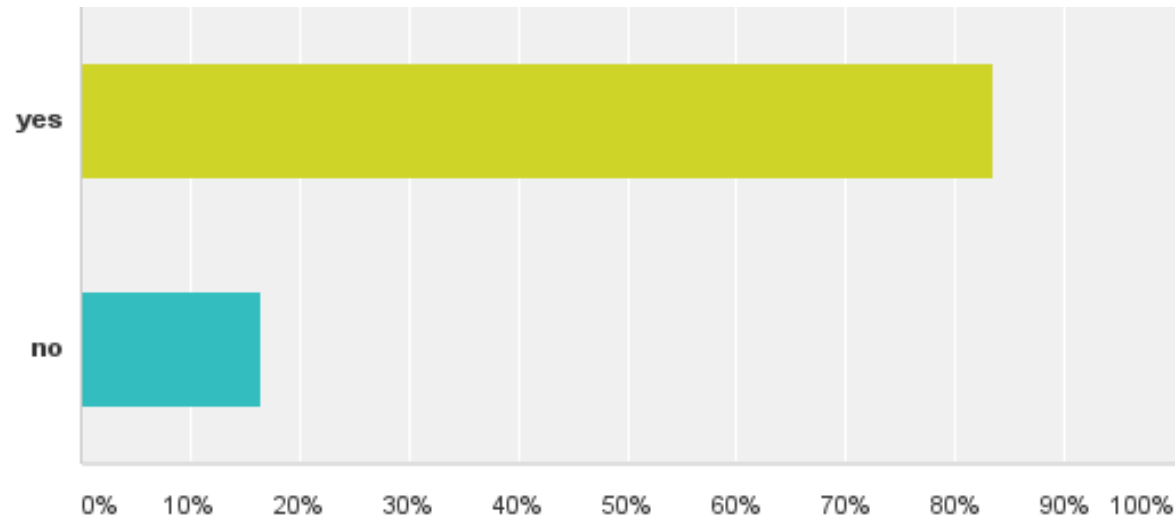

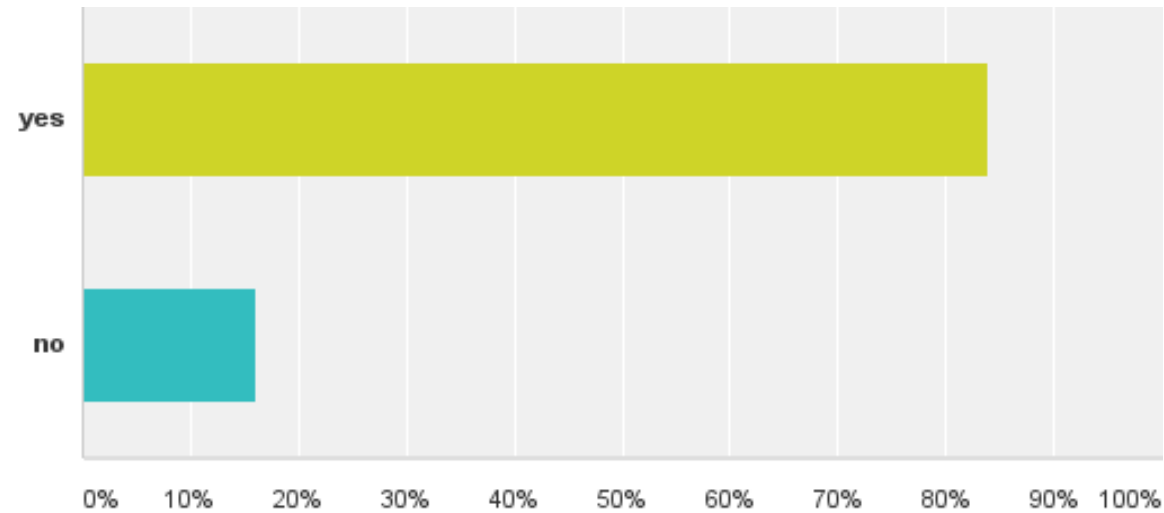

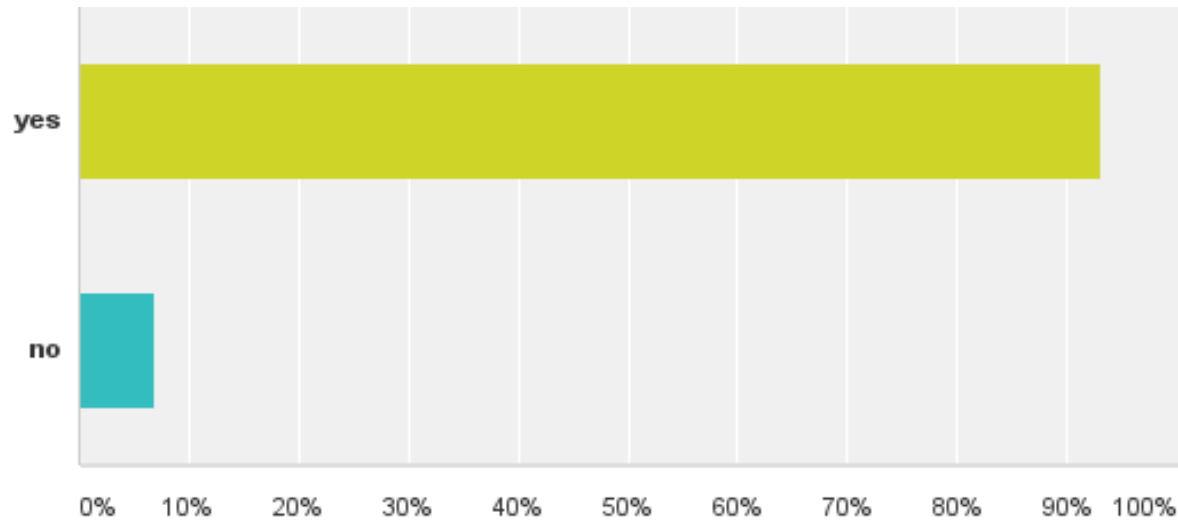

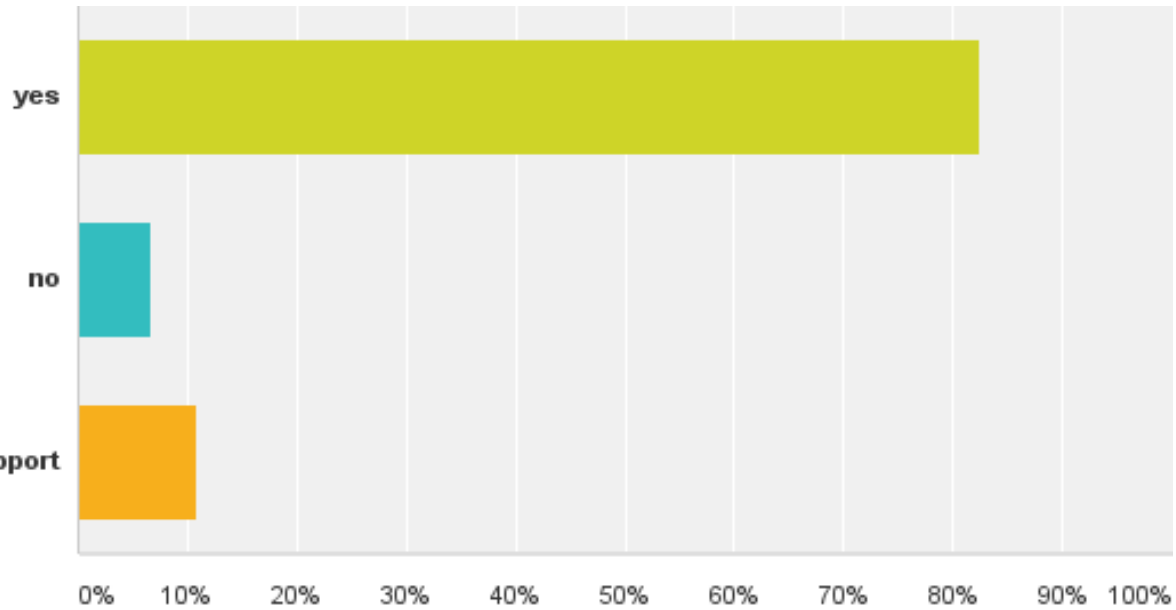

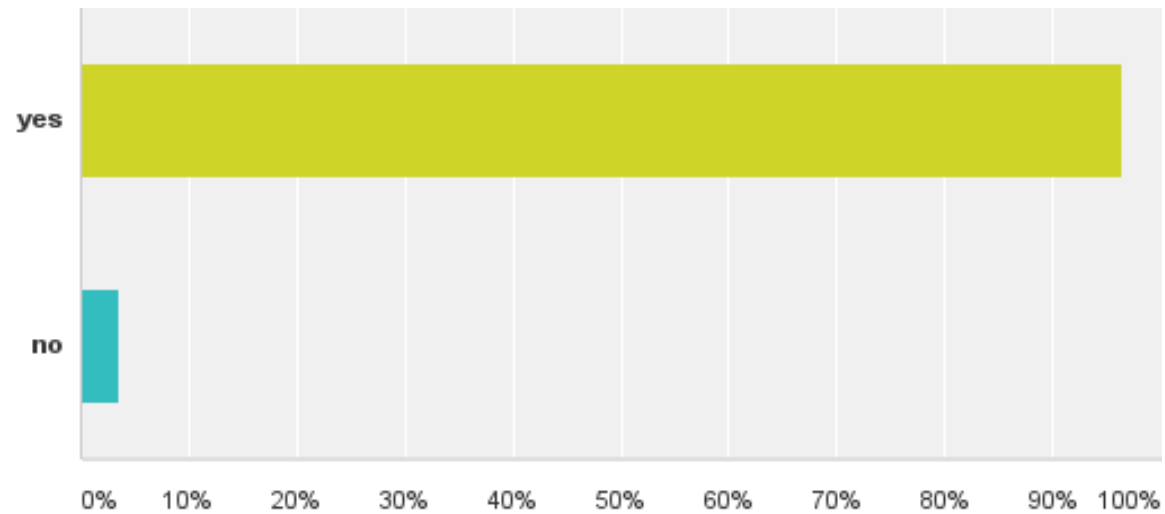

Q5: In the plan we say what we think is important for a good life in the community. This is our list. Do you agree with us?



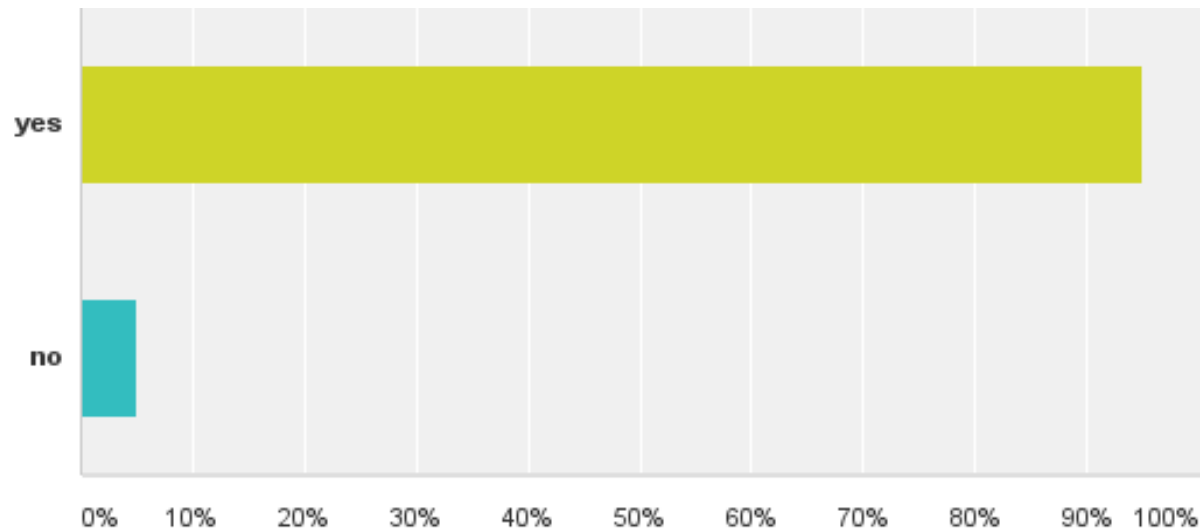
A good life in the community is living in the community with support from my family and carers

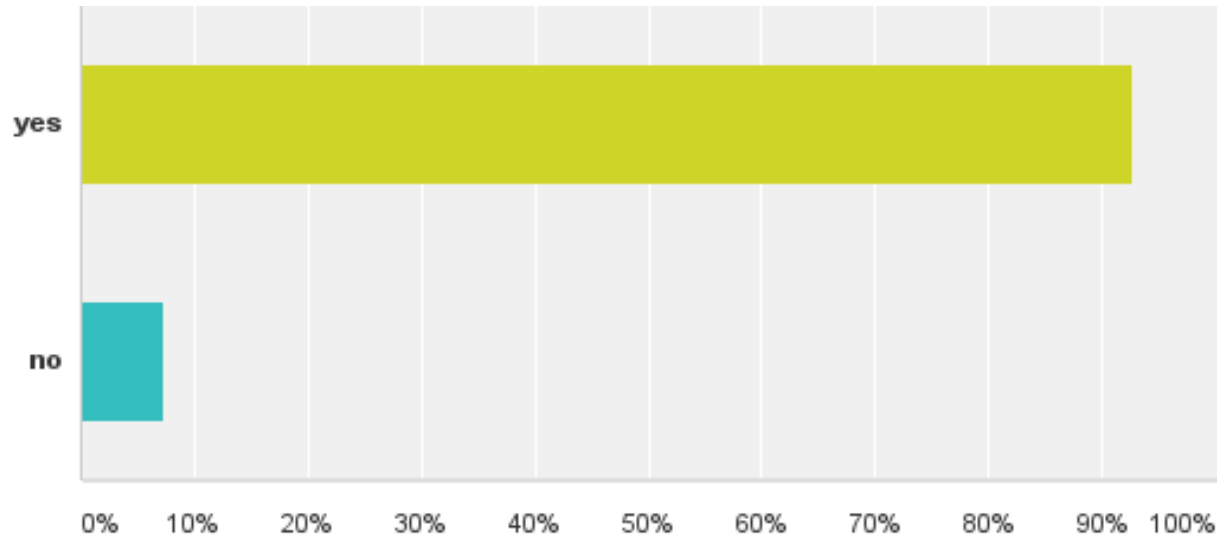
A good life in the community is getting good care from all health services

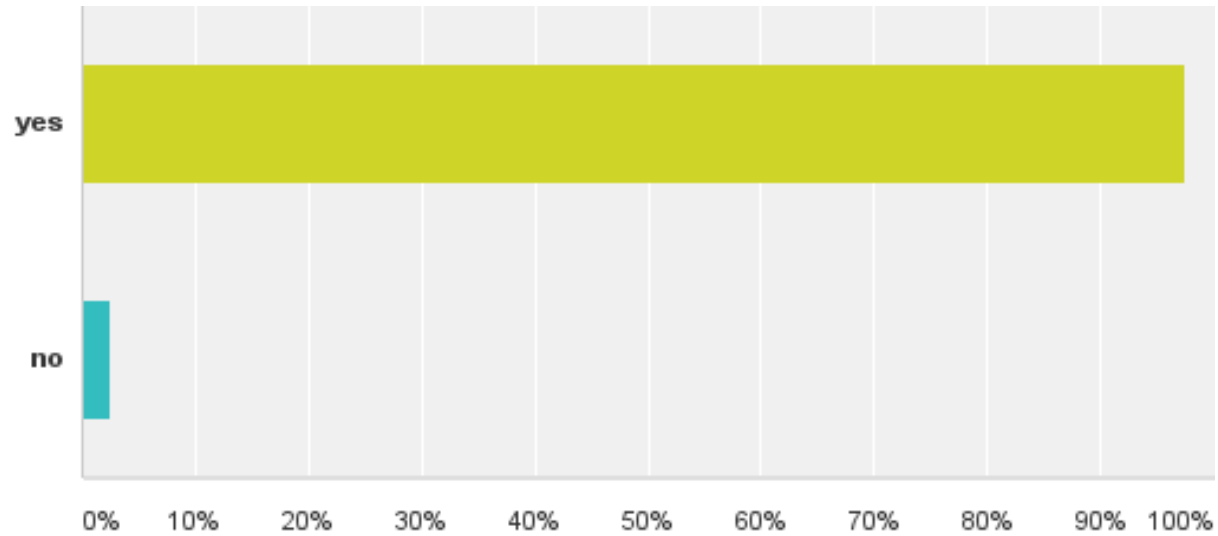

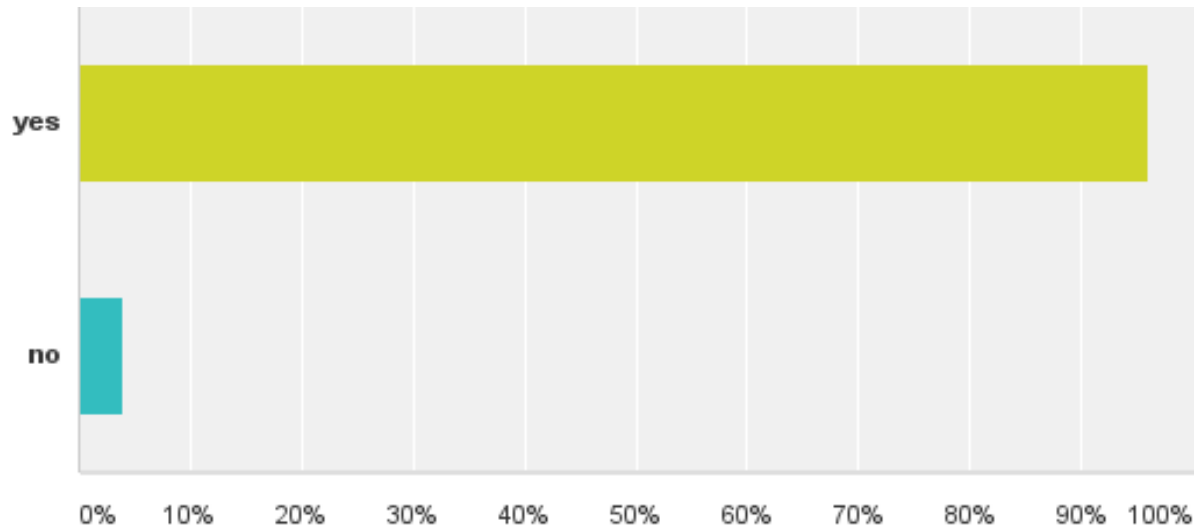
A good life in the community is feeling happy with everyday life

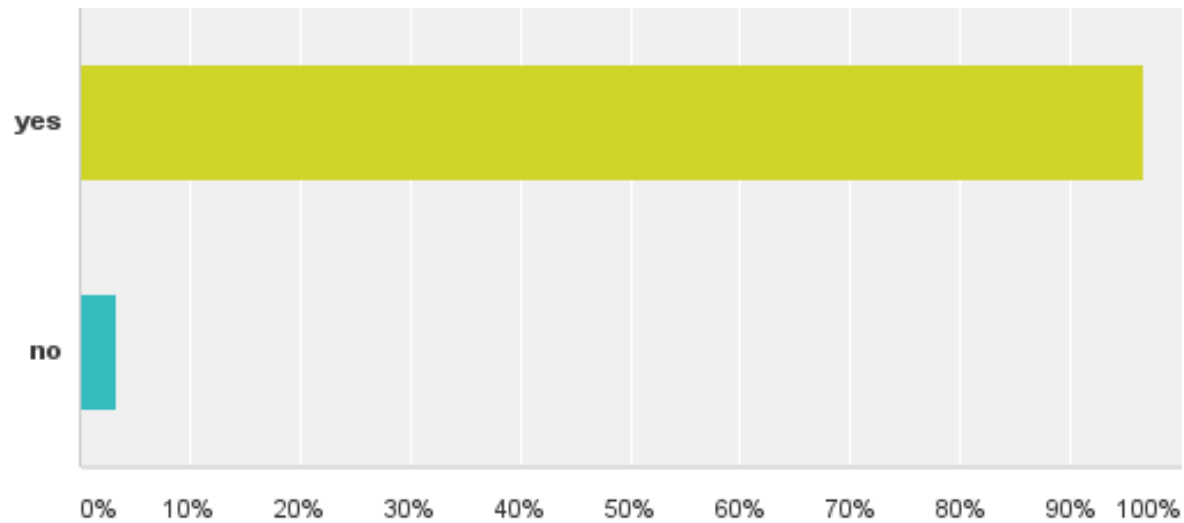

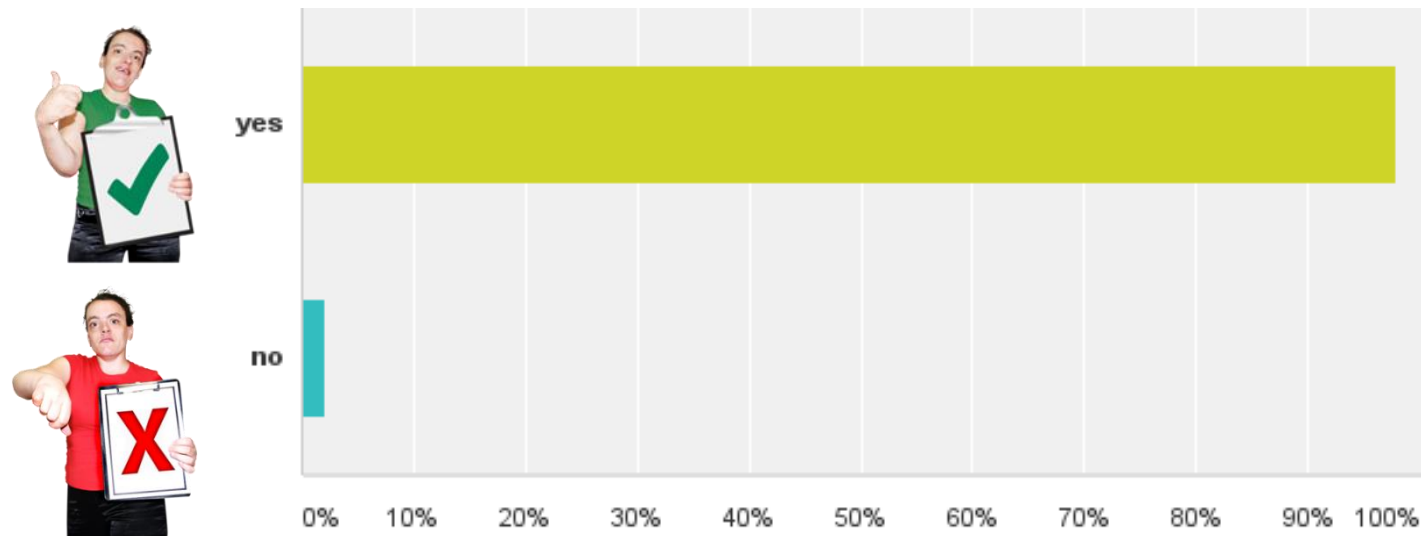

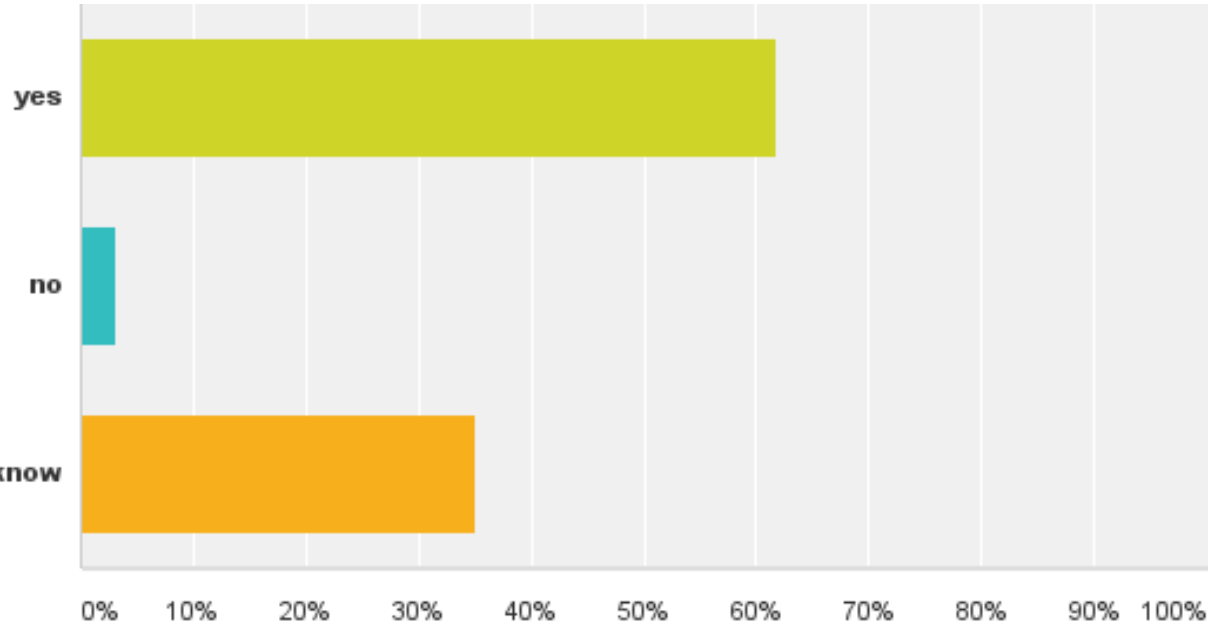

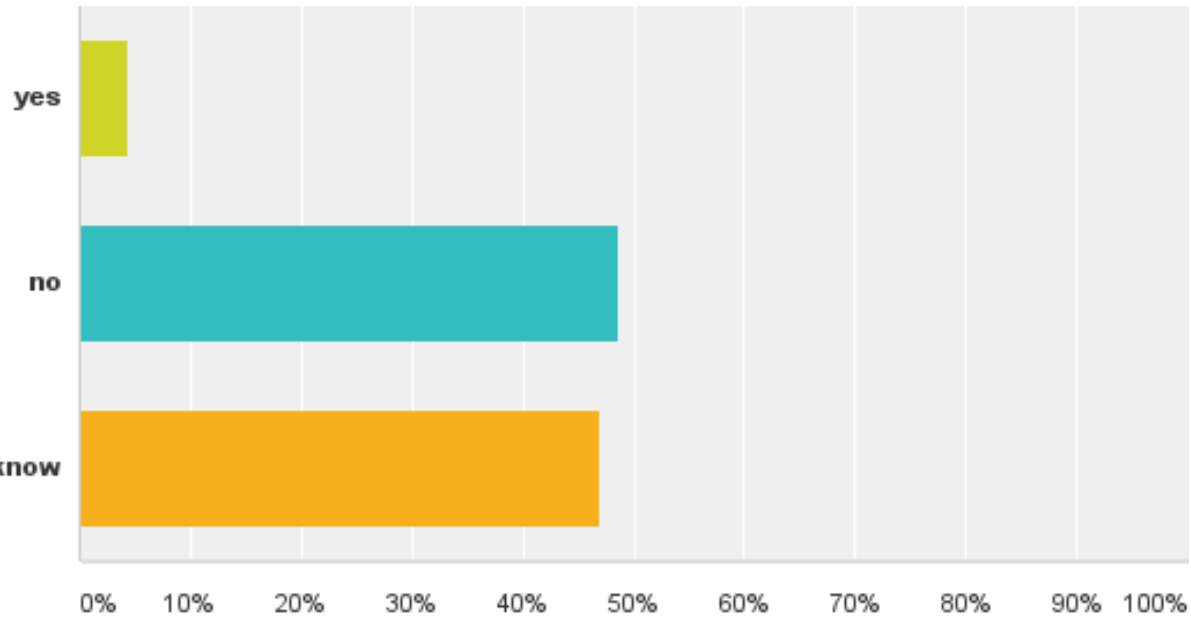
