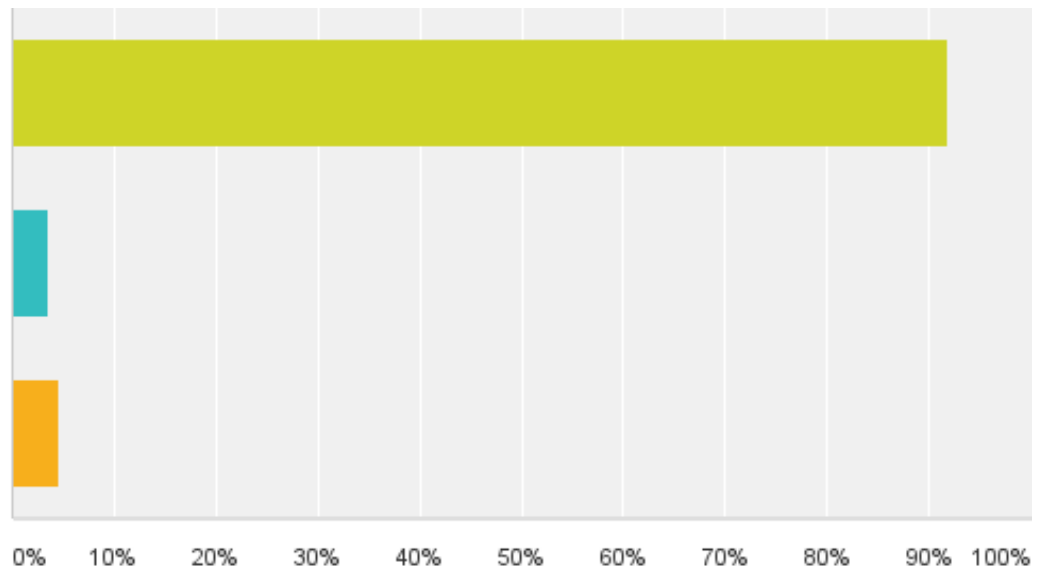

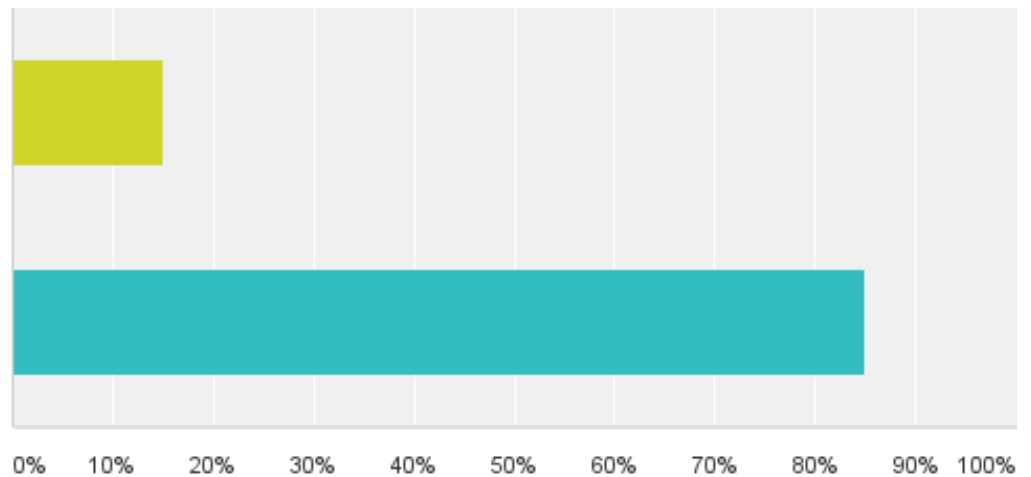
Q2: I am a man or woman

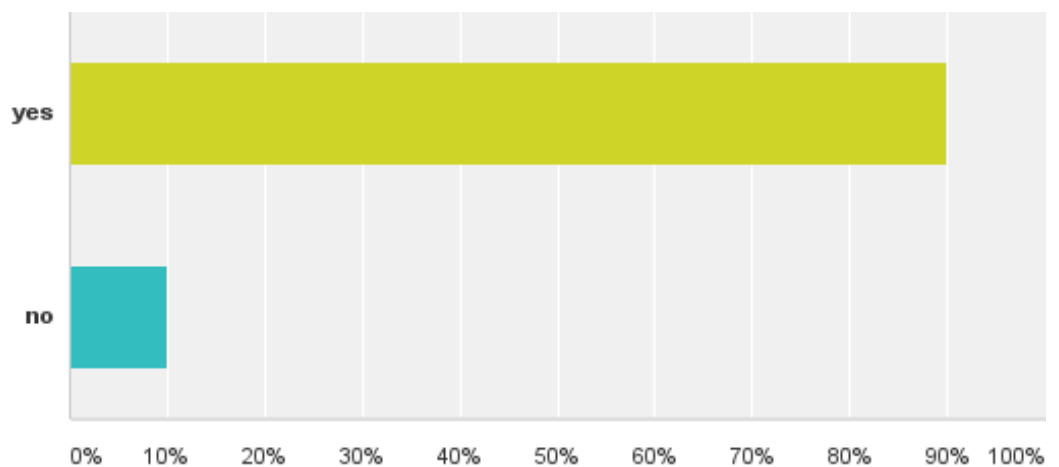

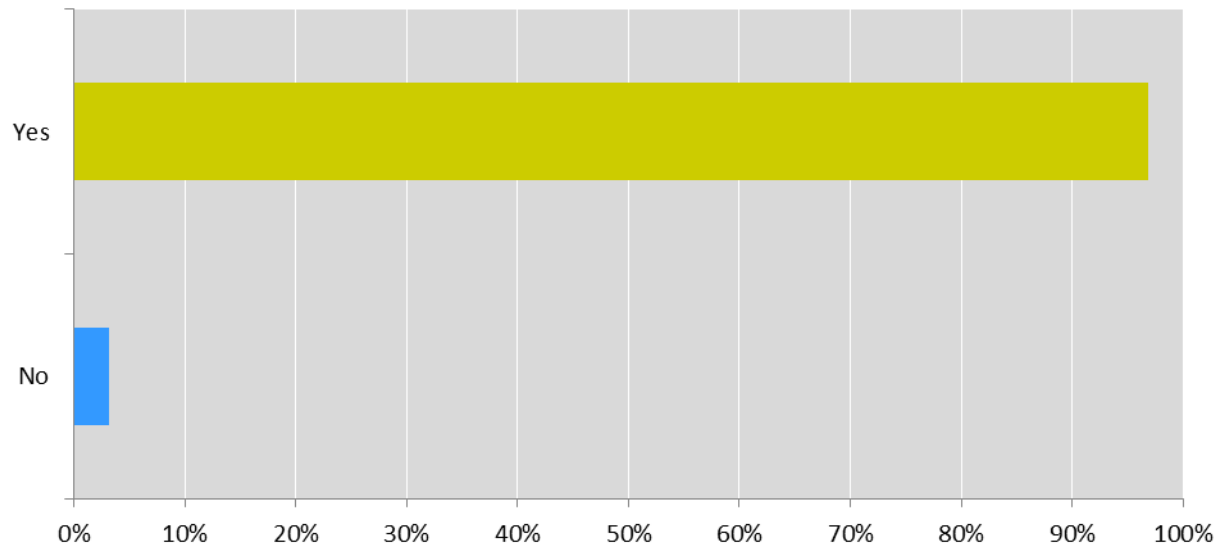

living in the community with support from their family and carers

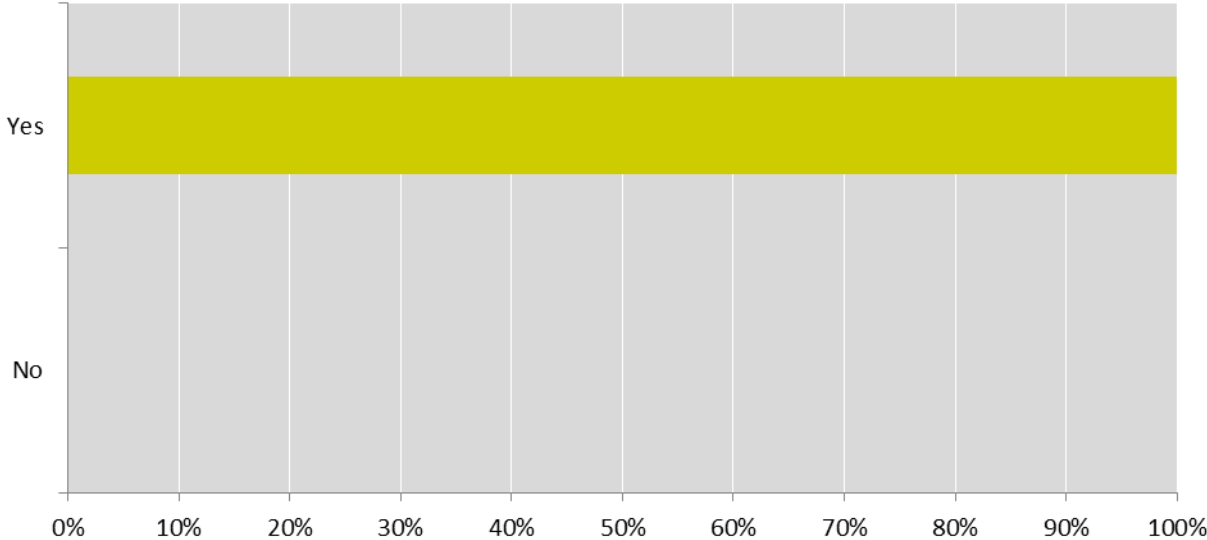

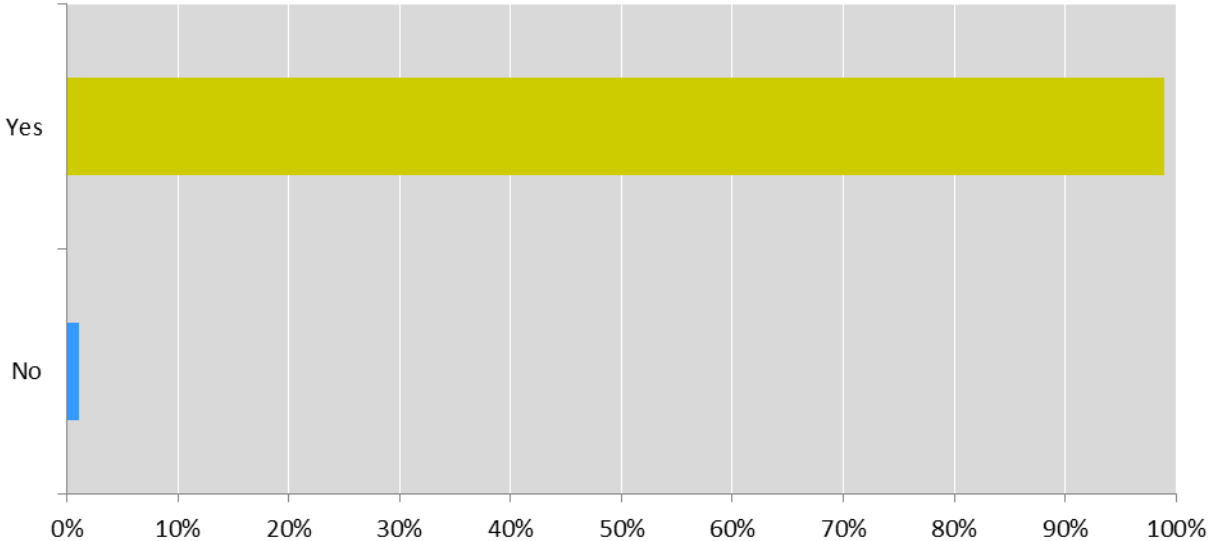

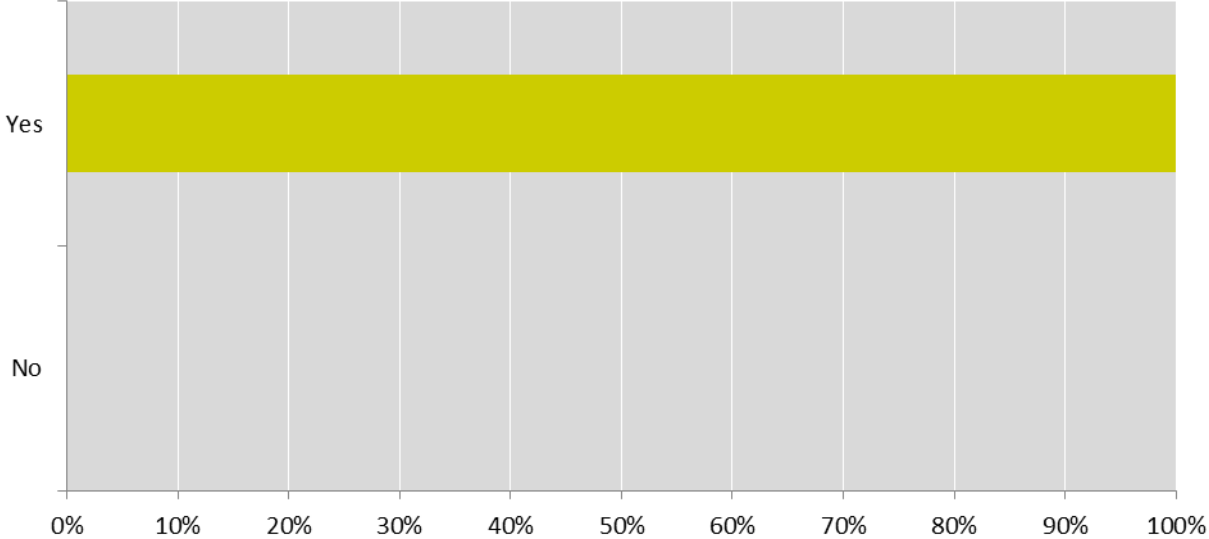

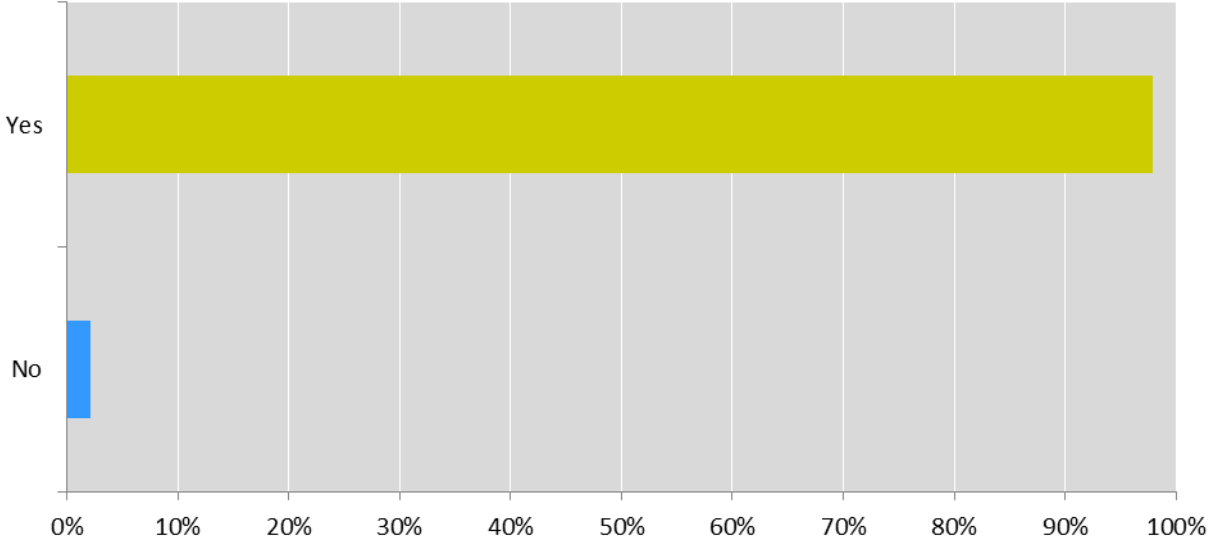

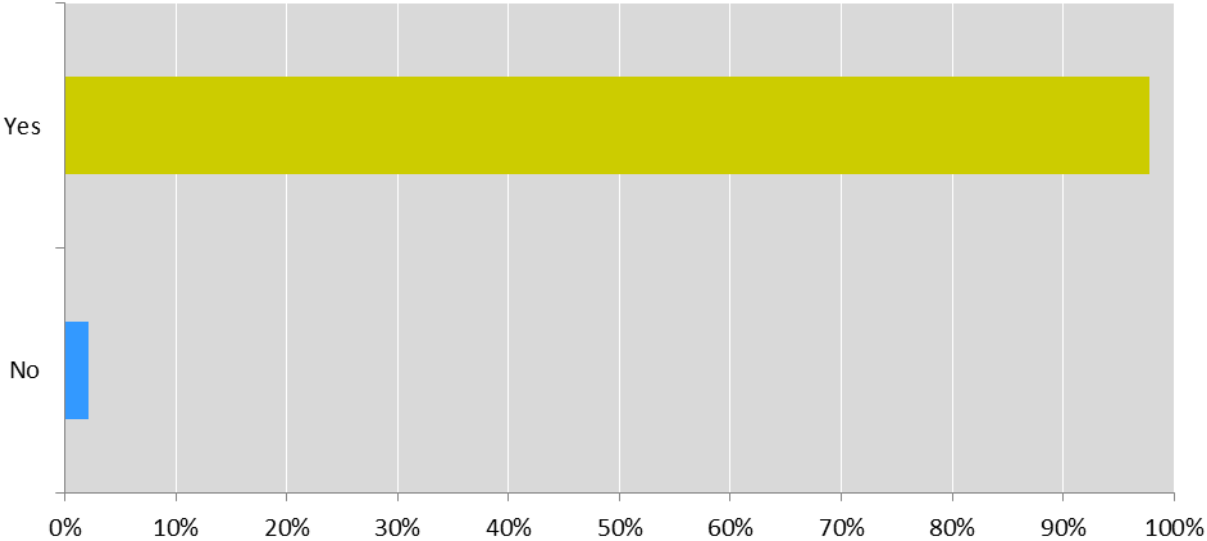

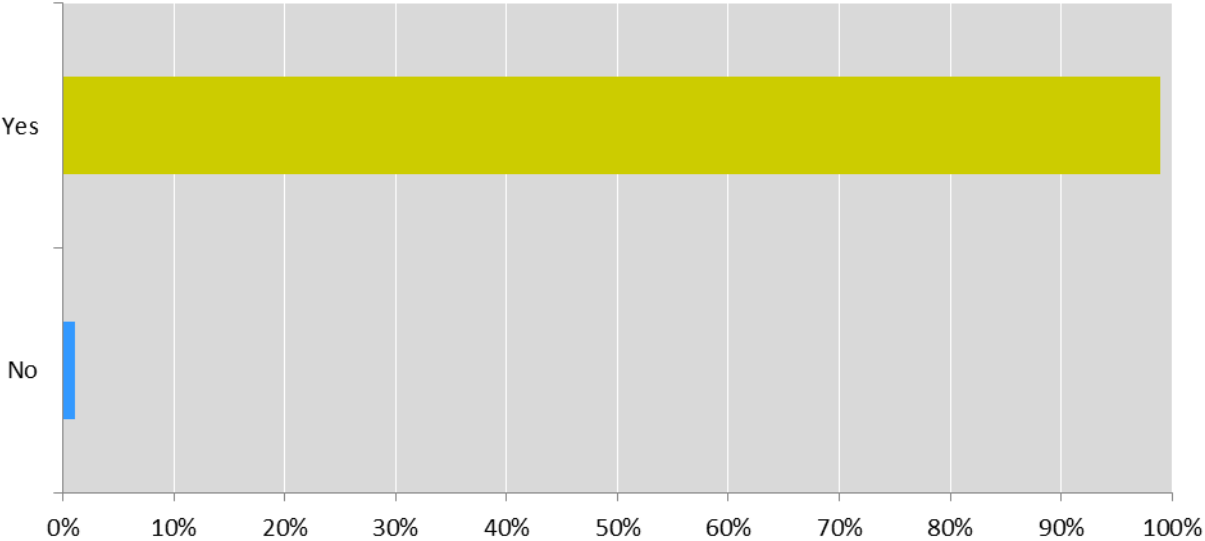
