

Barnes Cray Primary School

Iron Mill Lane County Primary School was founded in 1939 on a site in Iron Mill Lane, Crayford.

It changed its name to Barnes Cray County Primary School in 1948. In 1965 the school was transferred from Kent County Council to the London Borough of Bexley and was known alternatively as Barnes Cray Junior, Mixed and Infant School or Barnes Cray Primary School.
