

Northend Primary School

The Northend Junior and Infant Schools were built in 1903 on Northend Road, Crayford with places for three hundred boys, girls and infants.

In 1914 the two departments were combined to form a single Northend Council School. By 1924 the number of places had grown to three hundred and sixty. In 1945 the school was renamed Northend County Primary School. In 1965 it was transferred from Kent County Council to the new London Borough of Bexley and became known alternately as Northend Junior, Mixed and Infant School or Northend Primary School. It has remained on its original site throughout its history.
