

Pelham Primary School

Woolwich Road Council Junior and Infant Schools were opened in 1935 on the corner of Woolwich Road and Pelham Road, Bexleyheath.

In 1945 they were transferred from Kent County Council to the Borough of Bexley and renamed Pelham Junior and Infant Schools. From 1965 they came under the new London Borough of Bexley. The schools were merged into a single Pelham Primary School in 1984. They have remained on their original site throughout their history. There is also a Nursery School attached.
