

Royal Park Primary School

Footscray Place County Primary School was established by Kent County Council in 1951 on part of the old Foots Cray Place off Riverside Road, Sidcup.

An Infant School was added to the original Junior School in 1954 to form Royal Park County Primary School. Transferred to the London Borough of Bexley in 1965 the establishment was split into two separate bodies named Royal Park Junior School and Royal Park Infant School. In 1978 they combined once more as Royal Park Primary School.
