

HOW YOU CAN HELP

Terrorist's intent on carrying out deadly and determined attacks will conduct what is referred to as 'hostile reconnaissance' prior to an attack.

One of the most significant contributions anyone can make in combating terrorism is to remain vigilant and alert to such behaviour at all times. Look for suspicious behaviour or activity. Have any of your security measures been tampered with or breached? Why is someone taking photographs in a vulnerable area? Why are they taking note of security measures in place?

If your suspicions are raised call the police and try to monitor the person's movements. Otherwise call the Anti Terrorist Hotline 0800 789 321 and pass as much detail as possible. Your information could be the vital link in preventing a terrorist attack.

- A 12 month Business Continuity Management tool.
- Increased local engagement with Counter Terrorist Security Advisers (CTSA).
- Details of other Counter Terrorism initiatives.
- Written assessment report with recommendations covering:
 - Physical Security • Personnel Security
 - Information Security • Good Housekeeping and Risk Management
