

Westwood College

Westwood Central School for Boys and Westwood Central School for Girls opened on the Green, Welling in 1937.

From the beginning it shared a site with Westwood Junior and Infant Schools. In 1945 they were transferred from Kent County Council to the Borough of Bexley and renamed Westwood County Secondary School for Boys and Westwood County Secondary School for Girls.

In 1963 the Boys and Girls Schools were combined to form a single Westwood County Secondary School. From 1965 it came under the new London Borough of Bexley and was known as Westwood Secondary School. This was shortened to Westwood School in 1975 and then changed to Westwood College in 1993. The School has remained on their original site throughout its history.
