Bexley's Housing Support service provides help to residents and landlords with housing concerns.

Housing support may be able to help you if you are:

- In danger of losing your home or have been asked to leave where you are staying
- Worried about unpaid rent and other debts
- Finding it hard to manage your money
- Struggling with the changes to your benefits
- In need of support with finding and moving into your own accommodation
- Moving into a new place and not sure if you'll cope
- · Living with friends or family and want to know about your housing options
- Concerned about a tenant and would like further advice.

Who is this service for?

Housing Support can help any Bexley resident with a housing issue. We can help you if you are renting privately, live in social housing, own your home or have no fixed abode.

Landlords and **Housing Associations**

Our service is also for landlords who are leasing properties in the borough. If you are concerned about a tenant, for example if they are experiencing problems similar to those listed, you can contact us on their behalf. This option is available to private and social landlords, letting agents, advice services, voluntary organisations and other agencies who work with tenants.



What can we do?

Our housing support advisers can help with:

- Managing unpaid rent and other debts
- Budgeting household finances
- Advice around benefits, employment and training
- Finding and securing a property
- Advice and support on your current tenancy
- Getting in touch with the right people and services to help you
