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Bexley Community Safety Partnership – Joint Strategic Assessment (JSA) 2020

Introduction

This is the annual refresh of the Bexley Community Safety Partnership (BCSP) Joint Strategic Assessment (JSA) for 2020. The assessment provides a profile of crime and disorder in Bexley in 2019, and alongside data from the annual Bexley Crime Survey informs the priority setting process for the coming year. Priorities for tackling crime and disorder, directed by the evidence within this assessment, will be reflected in the BCSP Delivery Plan for 2020/21.

A full in depth JSA will be completed for 2021 and will coincide with both the refresh of the three year BCSP Strategy and the new Police and Crime Plan from the Mayor's Office for Police & Crime (MOPAC).

BCSP is the local partnership that delivers on the responsibilities of statutory organisations under the 1998 Crime & Disorder Act, to reduce crime & disorder in the borough. Statutory members include Police, Local Authority, London Fire Brigade, Probation and Health and they are supported by other non-statutory organisations including the community and voluntary sector. The partnership also links to other boards with joint responsibility on certain topics and works closely with the Adults and Children's Safeguarding Boards, Health & Wellbeing Board and the Youth Offending Team Management Board.

Caveats and interpretation of the Data

- Data cover the 2018 and 2019 calendar years.
- The data sources used are:
 - Metropolitan Police Service Crime and Data Dashboard and Hate or Special Crime Dashboard
 - MOPAC Crime Dashboard, Domestic Abuse and Sexual Violence Dashboard and Weapon-enabled Crime Dashboard
 - London Borough of Bexley SafeLives Data
- Where "London" figures are presented as benchmark data, this refers to crimes recorded by the Metropolitan Police Service that fall within the 32 London Boroughs (City of London not included).
- Police-recorded crime gives a picture of the crime occurring in an area
- However, it is reliant on (a) persons reporting the crime in the first instance and (b) the recording practices of the local Police Force.
- As such, Police-recorded crime provides a measure of the crime-related demand on Police, but not necessarily a full picture of crime.
- Breaking down crime into categories at a local level can result in small numbers. Random variation in these figures over time can cause seemingly large percentage changes.

- Tests of statistical significance show where change is not likely due to random variation alone (highlighted using the ¶ symbol).

Priorities

The Mayor's Office for Policing and Crime (MOPAC) set the mandatory London wide priorities as follows:

- Sexual offences
- Domestic abuse (DA)
- Hate crime
- Child sexual exploitation
- Weapon based (both knife and gun crime)
- Anti-social behaviour (ASB)

The two local volume crime priorities selected for Bexley for 2020/21 remain as:

- Non-domestic abuse violence with injury (VWI)
- Burglary

Findings from the JSA and Bexley Crime Survey suggest that the following 2020/21 BCSP priority areas that collectively tackle all the above should be:

- Violent Crime
- Victims (focusing on victims of these priorities including DA and Burglary)
- Anti-Social Behaviour

In addition to these three main priority areas, the following crosscutting topics will also be considered when tackling the named priorities. This is due to statistical and anecdotal evidence recognising the links to victims/perpetrators around these areas and the need for a co-ordinated partnership communication approach:

- Substance Misuse
- Mental Health
- Communications

BCSP Strategic Delivery Group

The BCSP Strategic Delivery Group sits under the BCSP Board and strategically coordinates actions from the Delivery Plan to help reduce crime and disorder offences in the borough. The group meets bi-monthly and each meeting is 'themed' to a different priority.

Bexley Community Safety Partnership Delivery Plan

The BCSP strategy produced for 2018-21 is underpinned by a Delivery Plan. The overarching objectives are set out below and overall, reflect the findings of the current JSA and Bexley Crime Survey.

- Keep people who live, work, study or visit Bexley safe by reducing crime and disorder, antisocial behaviour, reoffending and combating substance misuse; and
- act upon any barriers that prevent people who live, work, study or visit Bexley from feeling safe, to be a place where people can go about their everyday lives, day or night, confident in the knowledge that this is a place where people treat each other fairly and with respect, and they are safe from harm or the effects of crime and disorder.

In working together, the BCSP has also adopted the following new principles:

- Facilitate partnership working and information sharing processes between relevant agencies
- Support the development of intelligence around local crime and antisocial behaviour to enable resources to be deployed effectively
- Manage and oversee the delivery of the BCSP strategic delivery group and work processes to bring about reductions in crime and antisocial behaviour
- To ensure that all agencies are supporting and training staff for effective partnership delivery

Overview of Crime data

The majority of the following data pages show the London rankings for each crime type based on a rate per 1,000 population of each borough. This gives a truer picture of an areas crime issues when borough population is taken into consideration. We have also added the percentage change and direction of travel for the past 12 months, and in comparison to the whole of London. A two year line graph shows seasonal changes for offence figures and where applicable, minor crime categories explain the breakdown or make-up of each crime type. Immediately below are precis's of each crime type showing direction of travel and where applicable explaining any caveat for the change and/or a brief explanation of how we respond to them.

Offences breakdown by ward – This shows the top 10 offences in each Bexley ward and what percentage of crimes those offences represent. As expected, Bexleyheath and Erith are the top two wards for offence figures, and this further enforces the decision to have Police led multi-agency Problem Solving Processes (PSPs) in place in these wards to help tackle the crime issues collaboratively. Violence, vehicle offences, theft and burglary regularly feature among the top 4 crime types in almost all Bexley wards.

London Borough of Bexley offences – Features the number of offences and direction of travel for the major crime types. All offence types have seen an increase in 2019 with the exception of Sexual Offences which saw a small percentage drop over the year.

Total Notifiable Offences (TNOs) – TNOs are all the recorded offences added together. Like London overall and most other boroughs, Bexley has seen a rise in TNOs in 2019 of 16.9%[¶], from 15,369 to 17,968 offences per year. The percentage increase is double that of London, though the rate per 1,000 remains relatively low.

Arson & criminal damage – Bexley saw an increase of 6.3%, from 1,526 to 1,622 offences per year. This is against the London wide trend and has seen us slip from 11th to 22nd place for offences per 1,000 population. It should be noted however that many borough's offence rates are at a similar level.

Burglary – A large percentage rise in business and community burglaries in 2019 has been off set by a slight fall in residential burglary. This has resulted in a 7% rise in all burglaries overall from 1,640 to 1,755 offences per year. Burglary is one of two high volume local priorities for Bexley and multi-agency interventions that took place in Autumn 2019 lessened the increase in offences for the year.

Drug offences* – An increase of 15.6%, from 616 to 712 offences per year. The minor category “possession of drugs” makes up a large proportion of “Drug Offences”. The rise in drug possession offences has been partly due to an increase in targeted stop & search for that purpose. In contrast the low numbers of Drug Trafficking (or possession with intent to supply) have dropped further by some 20%. Substance misuse is a crosscutting theme across the BCSP priorities and is known to be a driver for many offences especially serious violence.

Possession of weapons* – An increase of 24.3%, from 107 to 133 offences per year. This high percentage increase is in part due to an increase in targeted stop and search although these are relatively low numbers of offences.

Public order offences – An increase of 21.4%[¶], from 949 to 1,152 offences per year and reflects a London wide increase.

Robbery – An increase of 17.3%, from 324 to 380 offences per year. Despite the rise in offences, numbers are low as a percentage of all London robbery offences.

Sexual offences – A decrease of 1.8%, from 388 to 381 offences per year. This reflects a small decrease London wide.

Theft – An increase of 0.5%, from 2,870 to 2,883 offences per year. Virtually unchanged on the previous year's figures and significantly better than the London wide increase of 13.6%. Bexley remains the lowest borough for theft offences per 1,000 population.

Vehicle offences – An increase of 42.9%[¶], from 2,403 to 3,434 offences per year. Vehicle crime is a high volume offence in Bexley, however the BCSP are of the opinion that it should be tackled by way of crime reduction similar to that of Burglary. This will raise awareness of what the public can do to help minimise theft of, and from vehicles. A shared social media communications message and information shared at events would sit alongside picking up on linked series of thefts swiftly to improve chances of detection. Due to presenting lower threat, risk and harm, vehicle crime will not be a named priority for the BCSP in 2020/21.

Violence against the person – An increase of 21.7%[¶], from 4,338 to 5,280 offences per year. Although the recording of VATP offences covers a broad range of crime types, this large increase enforces our decision to have Violent Crime as a named priority for the BCSP. Our response includes our own Serious Violence Strategy and Knife Crime & Serious Violence Action Plan (aka the KCAP) as well as referrals into the Serious Violence Prevention Panel (SVPP).

Domestic Abuse Incidents** – An increase of 17.4%[¶], from 3,267 to 3,835 offences per year. Domestic Abuse is a mandatory London wide priority and a welcomed increase in reporting of incidents has seen a rise in current and historic offence recording. A new Domestic Abuse strategy is being produced which will further support DA victims and families whilst attempting to address offending behaviour of perpetrators.

Anti-Social Behaviour – An increase of 8.4%[¶], from 4,630 to 5,019 offences per year. Despite this rise Bexley has performed better than last year against other boroughs. ASB perpetrators can be referred through to, and managed by, the multi-agency ASB Prevention Panel (ASBPP) and appropriate tools and powers are used to desist their behaviour. ASB is also a named BCSP priority.

Non-Domestic Abuse Violence with Injury** – An increase of 22.2%[¶], from 1,035 to 1,265 offences per year. Non DA VWI is the BCSP's other local volume crime priority and like VATP offences is tackled holistically under the Violent Crime priority umbrella.

Hate Crime** – The sub-categories of Hate Crime cannot be summed to give an overall figure. These offence figures are relatively low in number especially when looked at as a percentage of all London offences. Hate Crime issues will form part of a future local and wider Victims strategy. Victims is also a named BCSP priority.

Weapon-enabled Crime** – The sub-categories of Weapon-enabled Crime cannot be summed to give an overall figure. One of the three minimum standards of the Knife Crime & Serious Violence Action Plan (aka the KCAP) is for the BCSP Board Meeting agendas to include Knife, Gun and Serious Violence

Performance, habitual knife carriers, community tension monitoring and stop and search as standing items. Therefore these figures are presented quarterly at the BCSP Board by the Borough Superintendent.

Bexley Crime Survey – In both the 2018 and 2019 surveys, the number one priorities for respondents were ‘Burglary’ and ‘Anti-social Behaviour from groups of people loitering’. There were 1171 respondents to the 2019 Bexley Crime Survey compared to 1304 in 2018. The top 3 crime type concerns were: Burglary, Drugs and Vehicle Crime. The top 3 ASB concerns were: ASB from groups loitering, Vehicle nuisance (noisy cars, bike gangs etc) and Drug paraphernalia. These concerns mirror our findings from the data in this JSA and help contribute to the CSP priority decision making process.

* The volume of “possession” offences recorded is heavily influenced by police activities and priorities (e.g “Stop and Search”). In such cases, recorded crime figures may indicate police activity in this area rather than levels of criminality.

** These categories are created by using “flags” and formatting the data in different ways. Therefore, these Incidents and Offences will be counted again in the other crime categories listed above.

The change is statistically significant at the 95% confidence level.

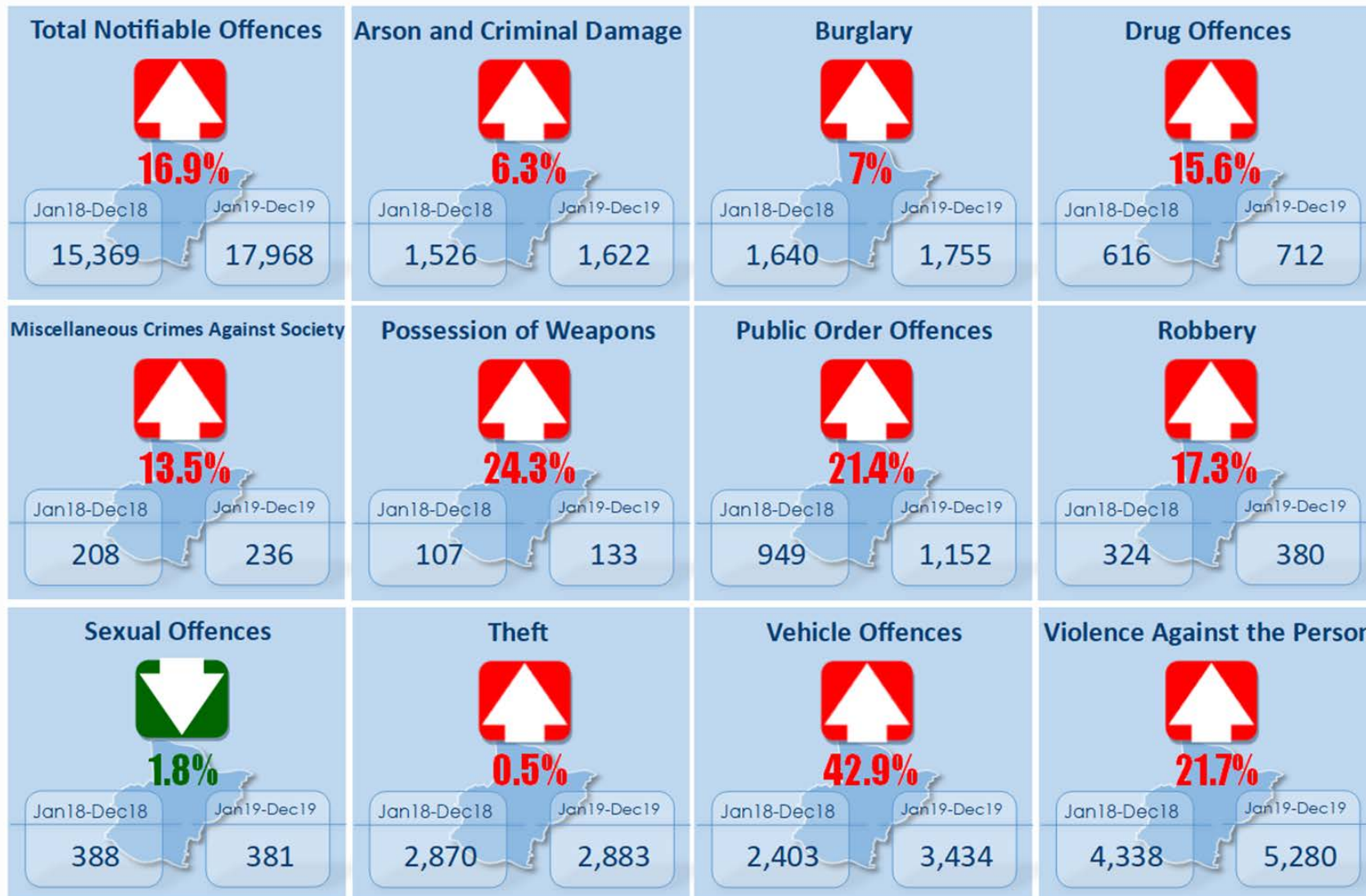

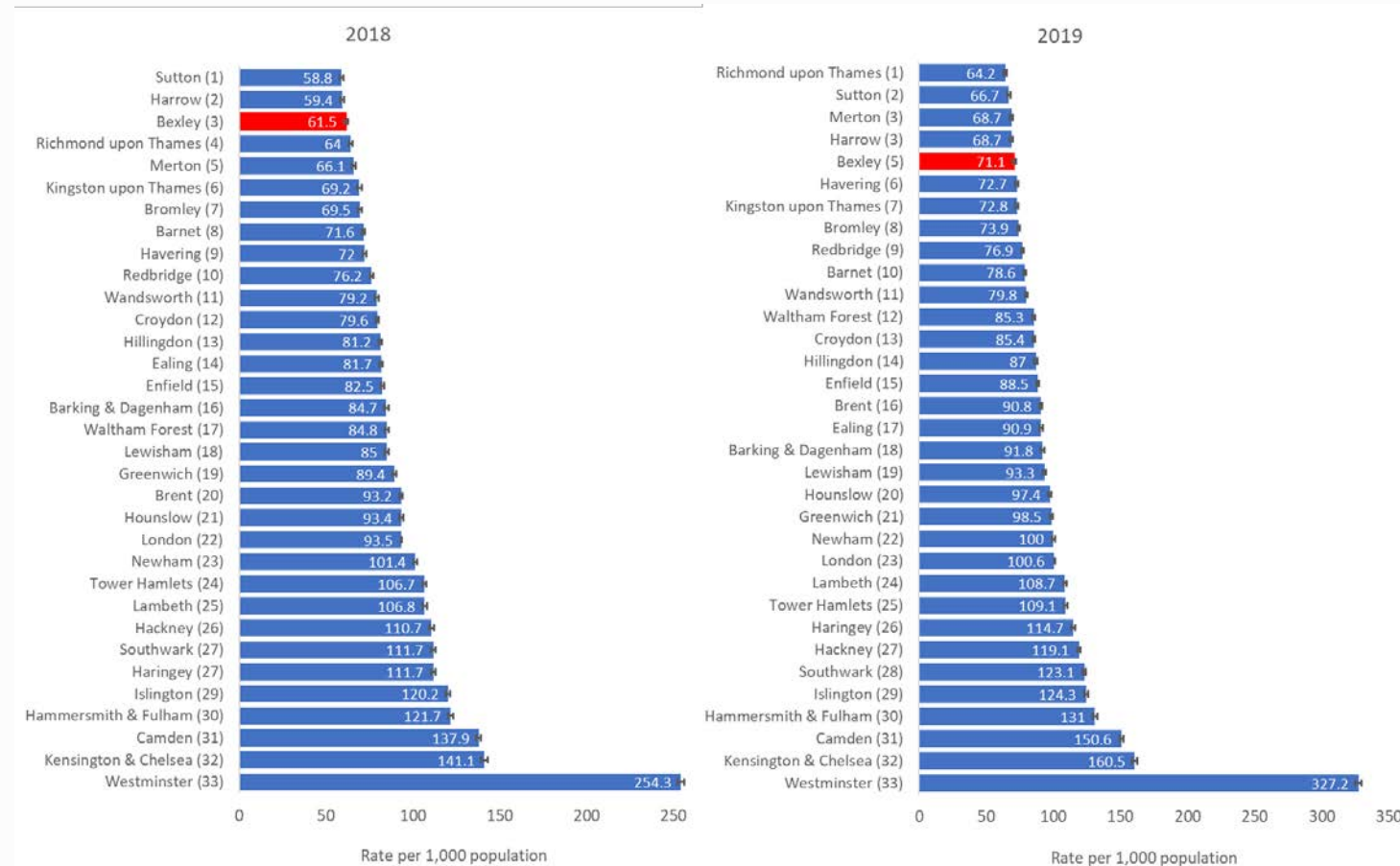
London Borough of Bexley Offences, 2018 vs 2019 calendar years



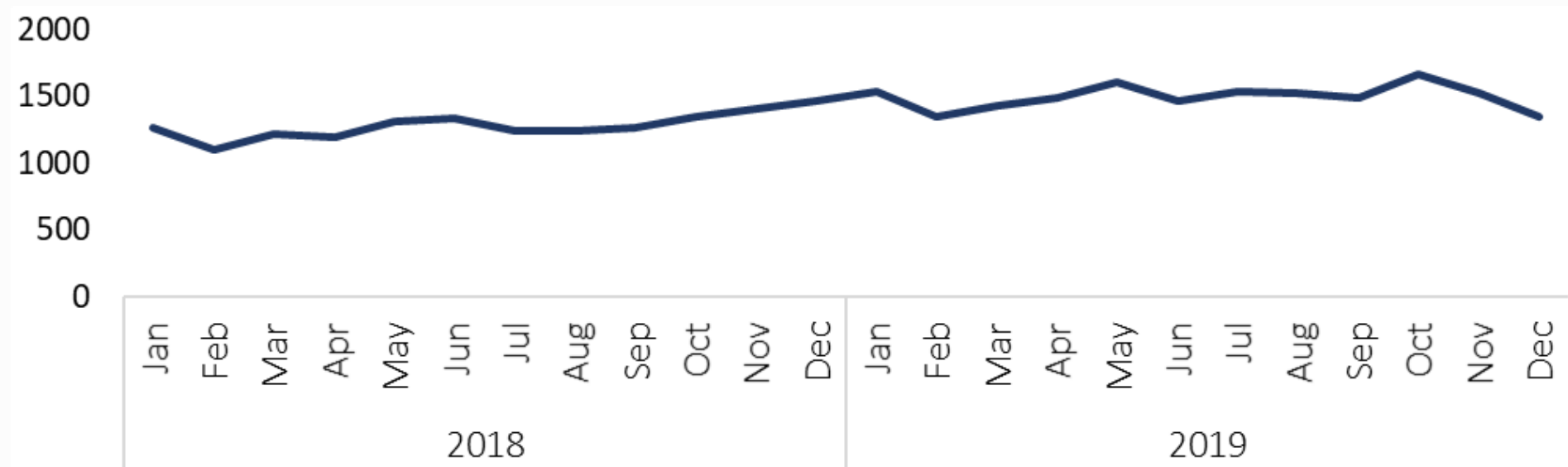

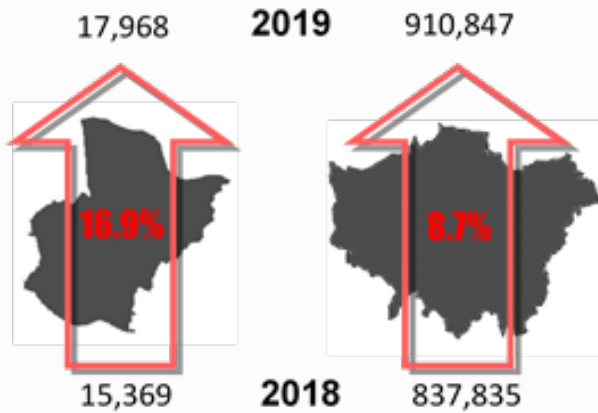
Comparison of calendar year rates for Total Notifiable Offences, London Boroughs, London:



Monthly counts of Total Notifiable Offences, London Borough of Bexley:

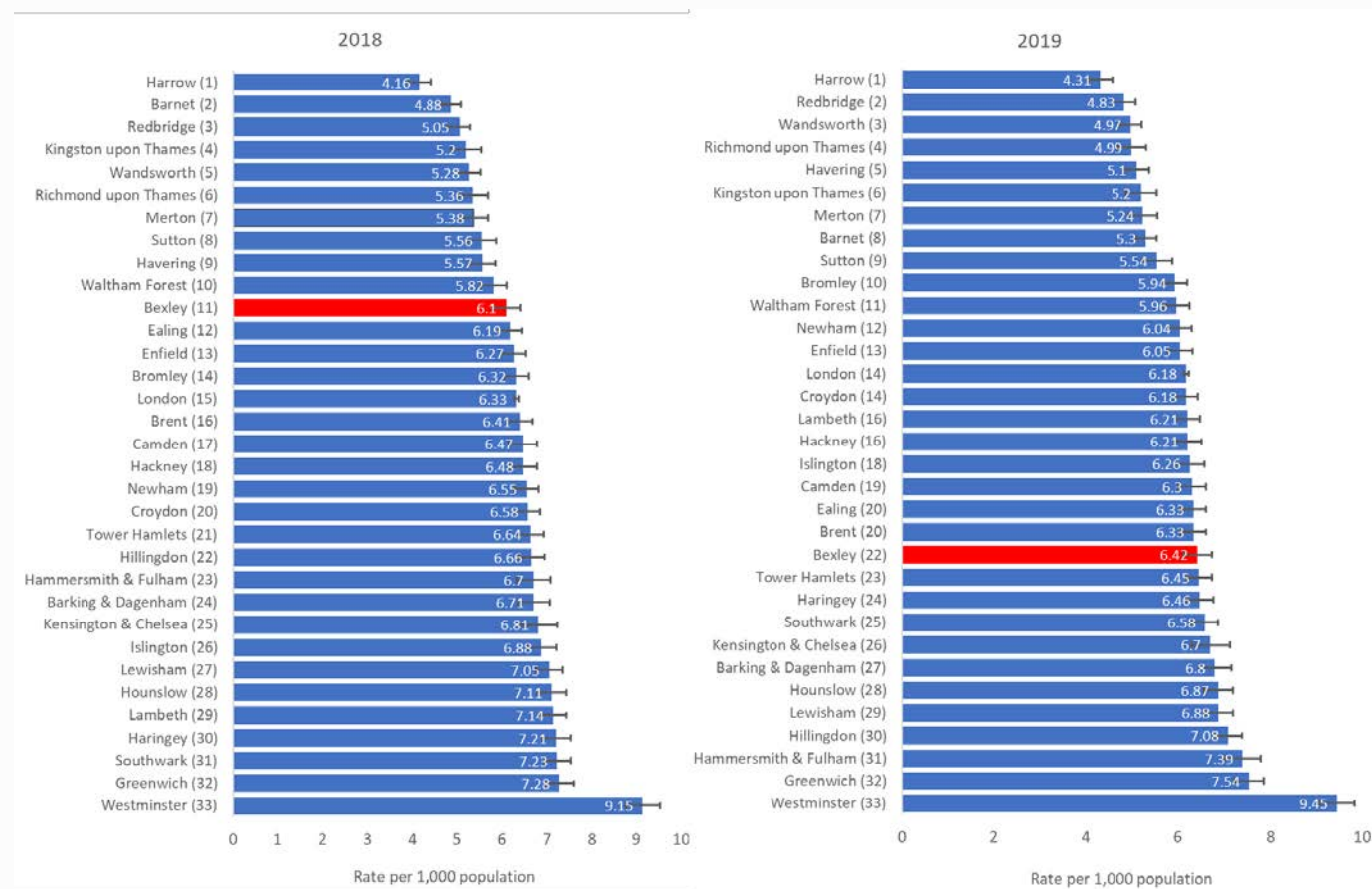


Comparison of Yearly counts for Total Notifiable Offences across Bexley and London:

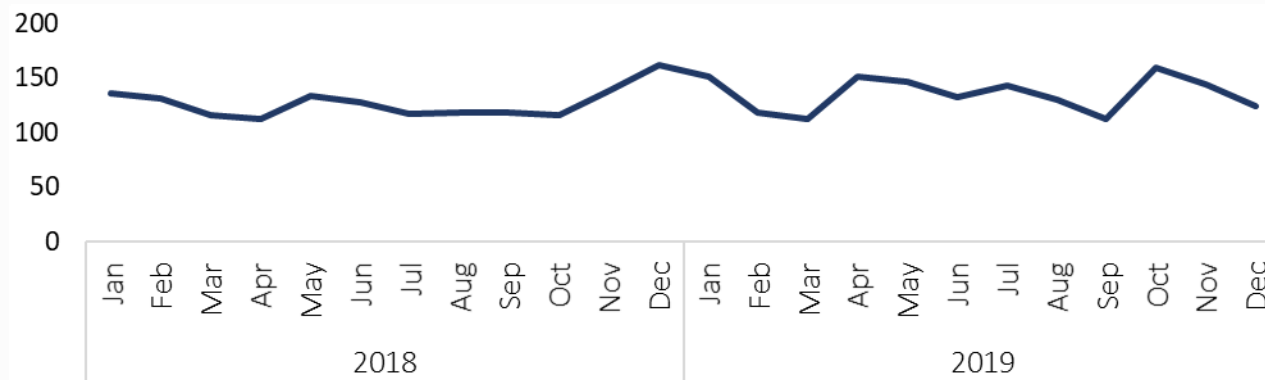

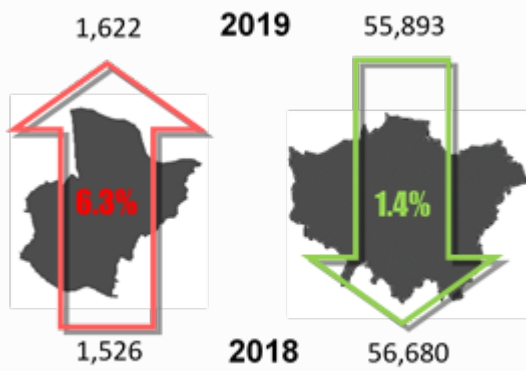
Comparison of Yearly rates for Arson and Criminal Damage, London Boroughs, London:



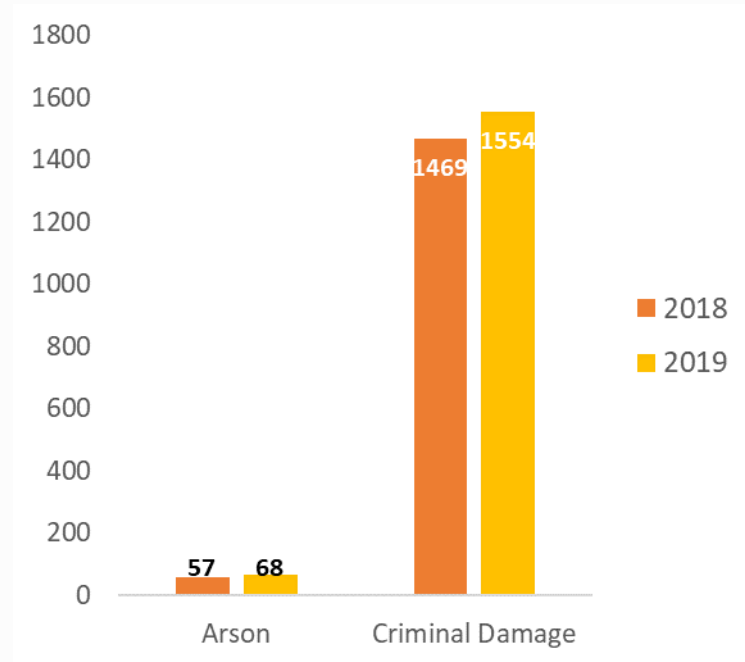
Monthly counts for Arson and Criminal Damage, London Borough of Bexley:



Comparison of Yearly counts for Arson and Criminal Damage, Bexley and London:

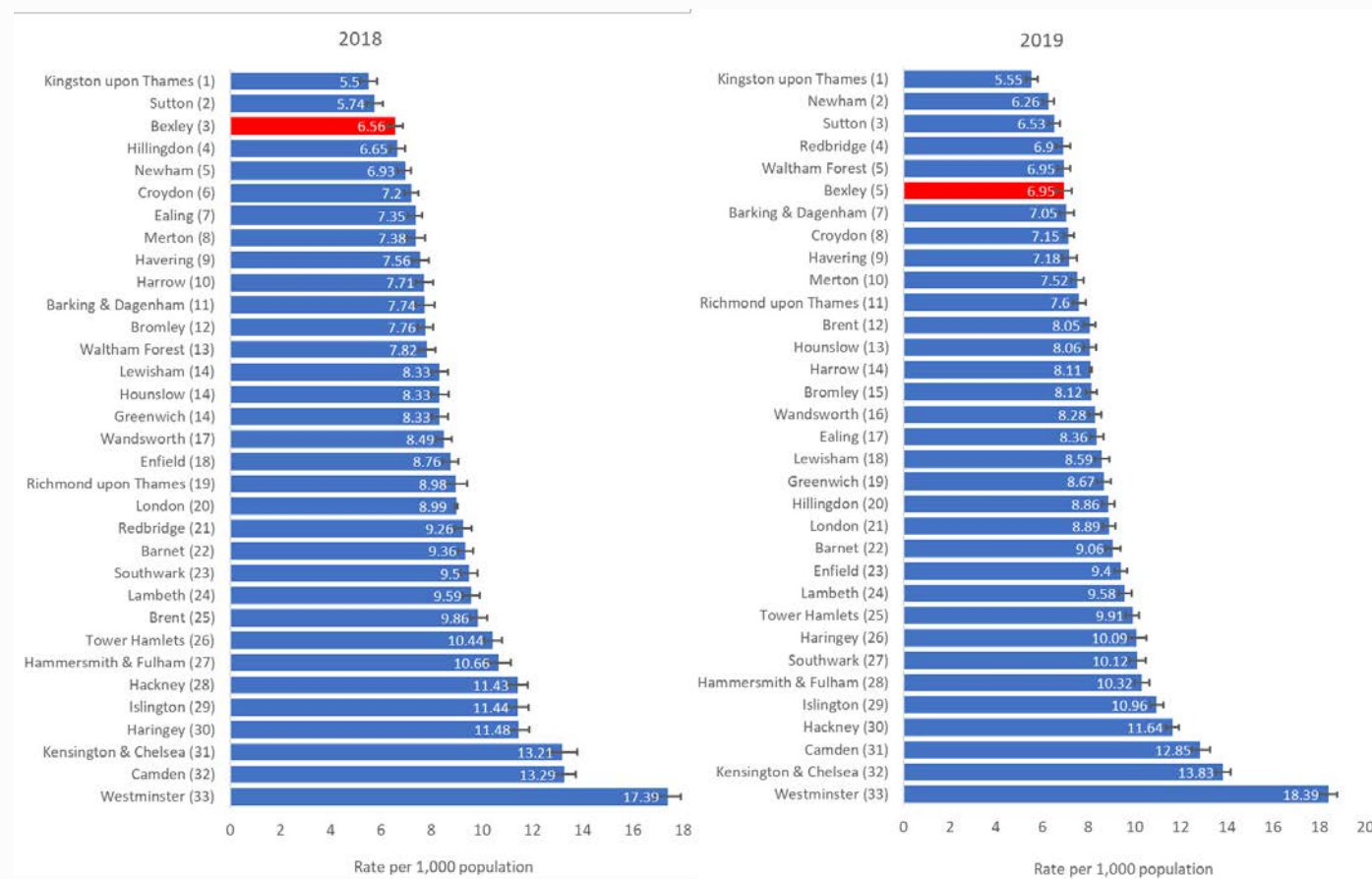

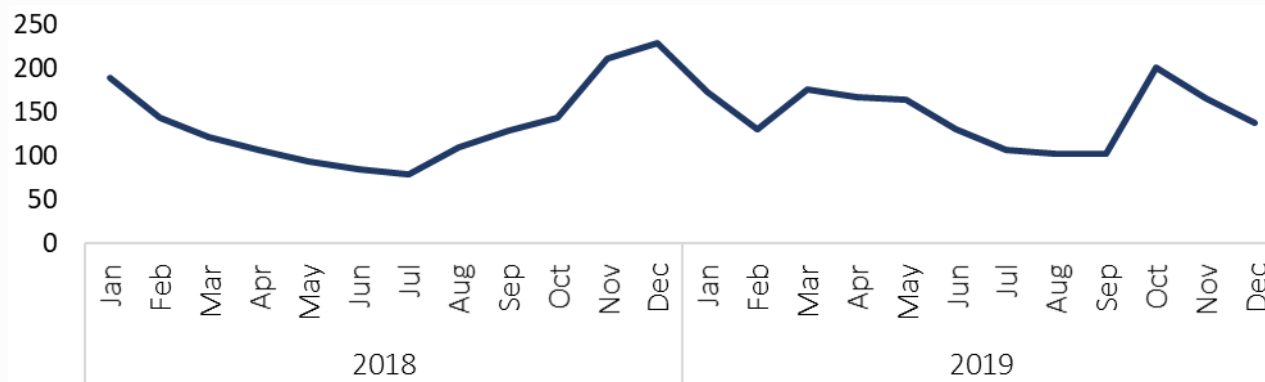

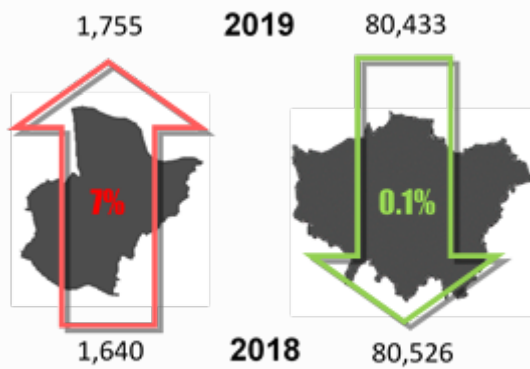
Comparison of Yearly rates for Burglary, London Boroughs, London



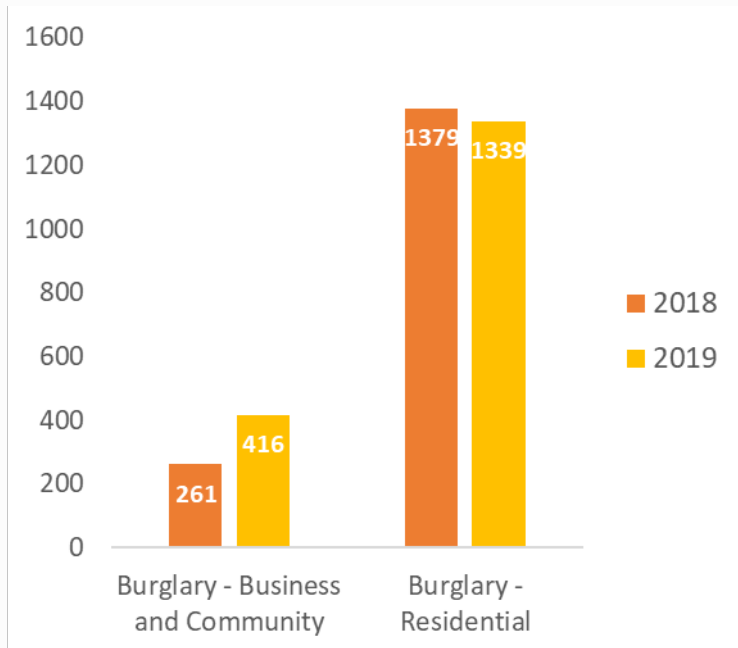
Monthly counts for Burglary, London Borough of Bexley:



Comparison of Yearly counts for Burglary, Bexley and London:

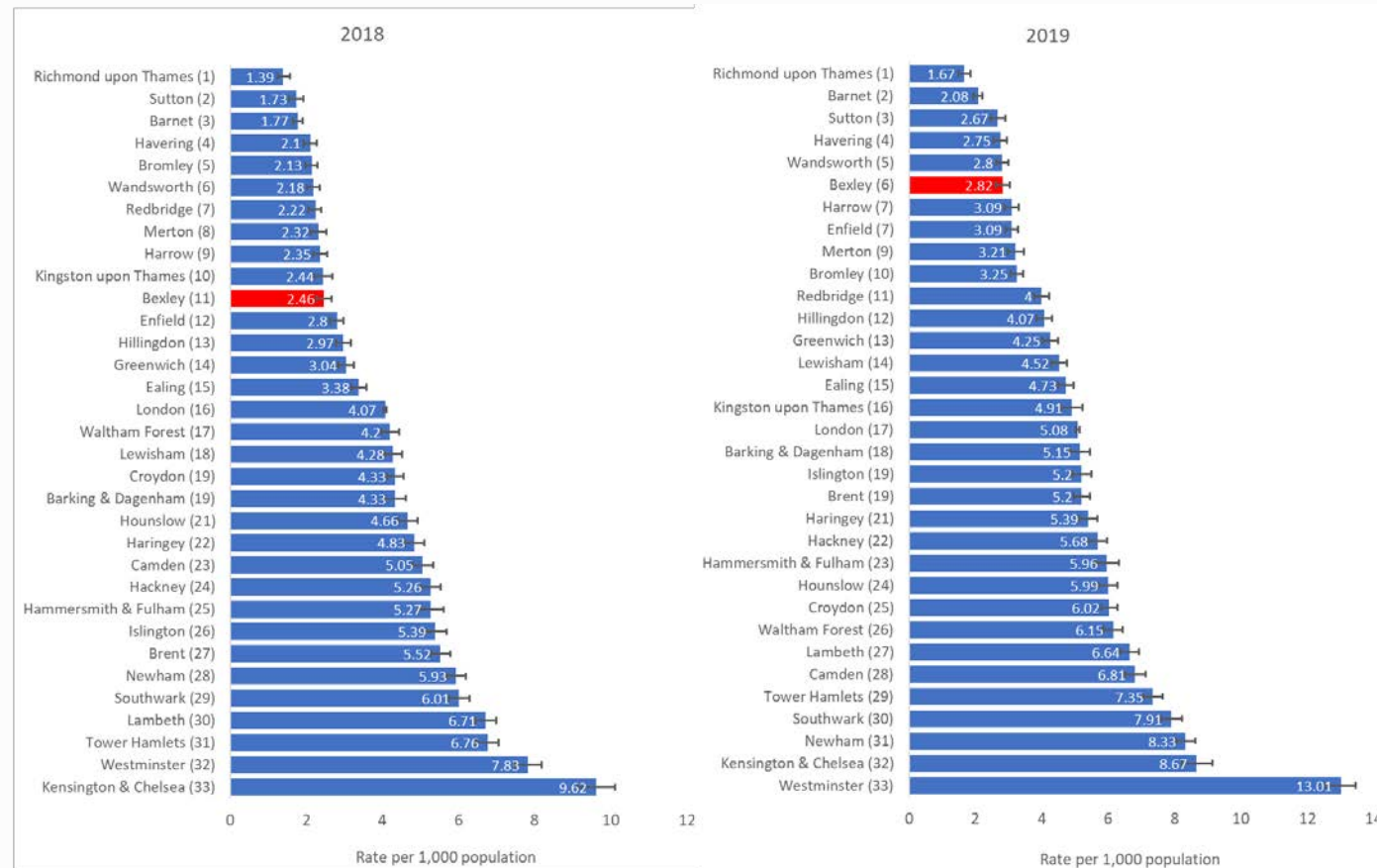

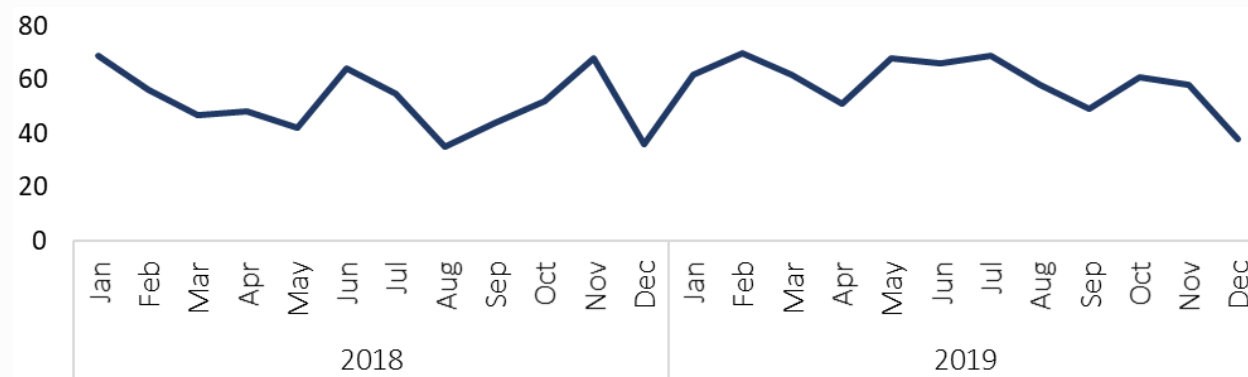

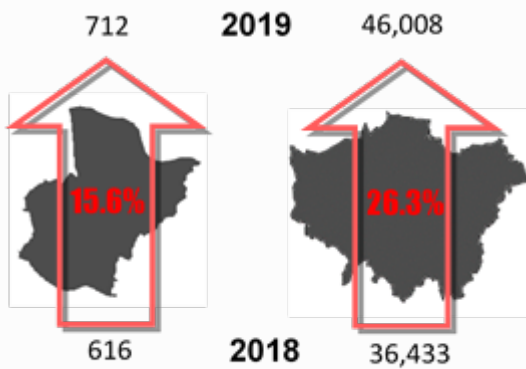
Comparison of Yearly rates for Drug Offences, London Boroughs, London



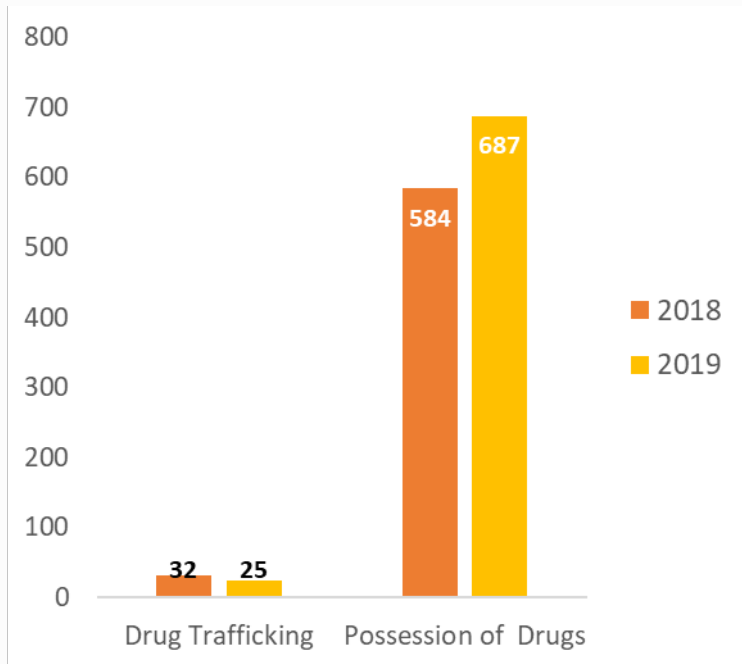
Monthly counts for Drug Offences, London Borough of Bexley



Comparison of Yearly counts for Drug Offences, Bexley and London

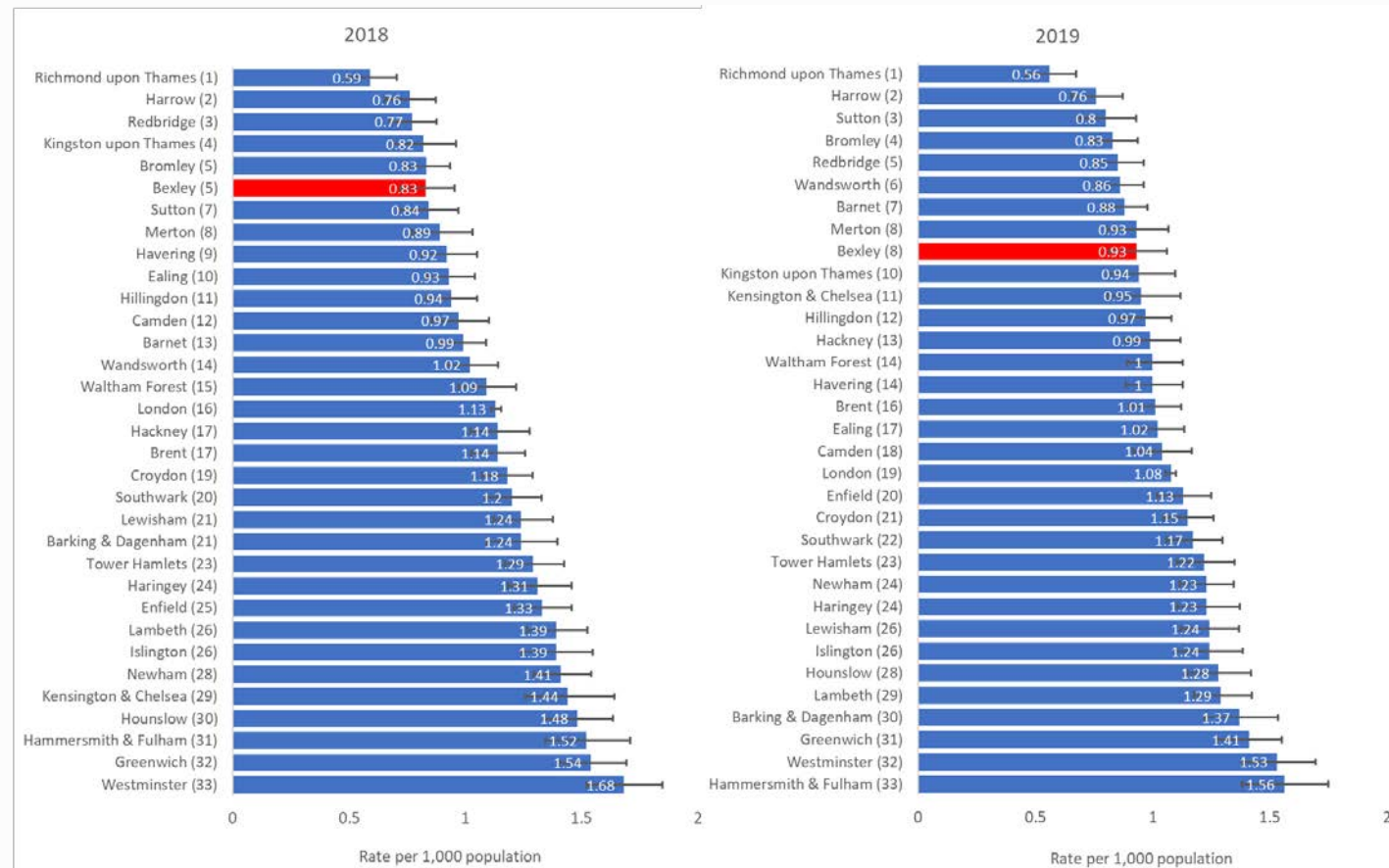

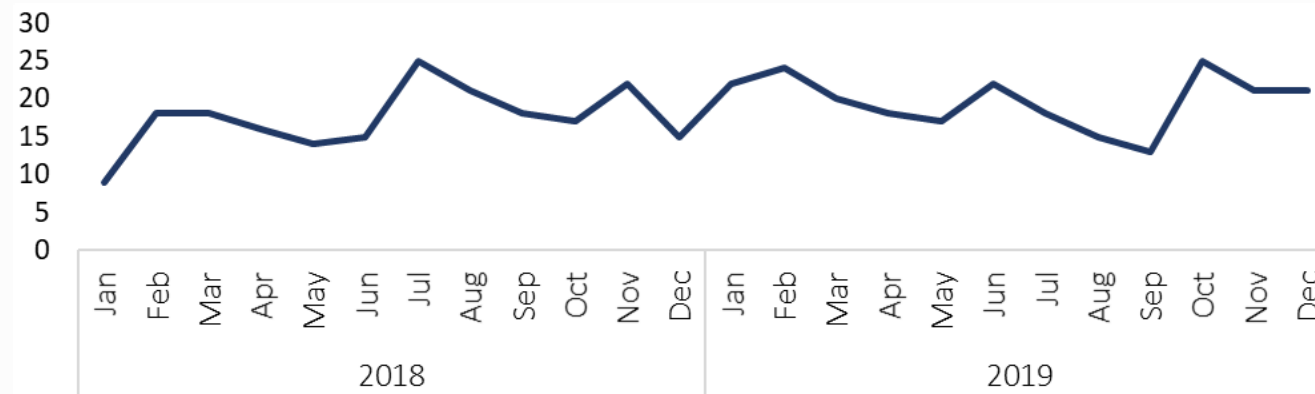

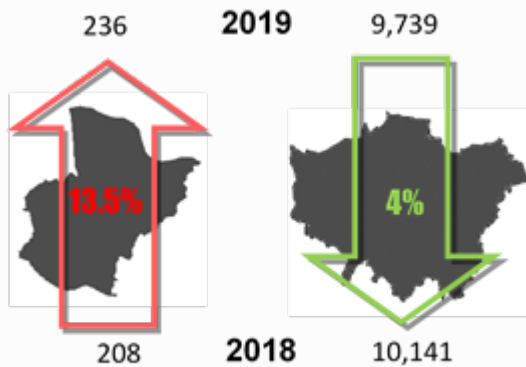
Comparison of Yearly rates for Miscellaneous Crimes Against Society, London Boroughs, London



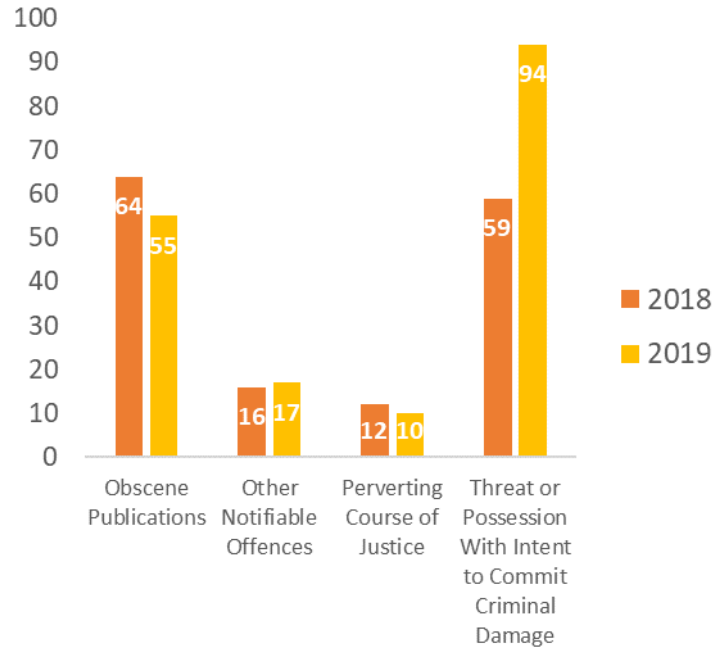
Monthly counts for Miscellaneous Crimes Against Society, London Borough of Bexley



Comparison of Yearly counts for Miscellaneous Crimes Against Society, Bexley and London

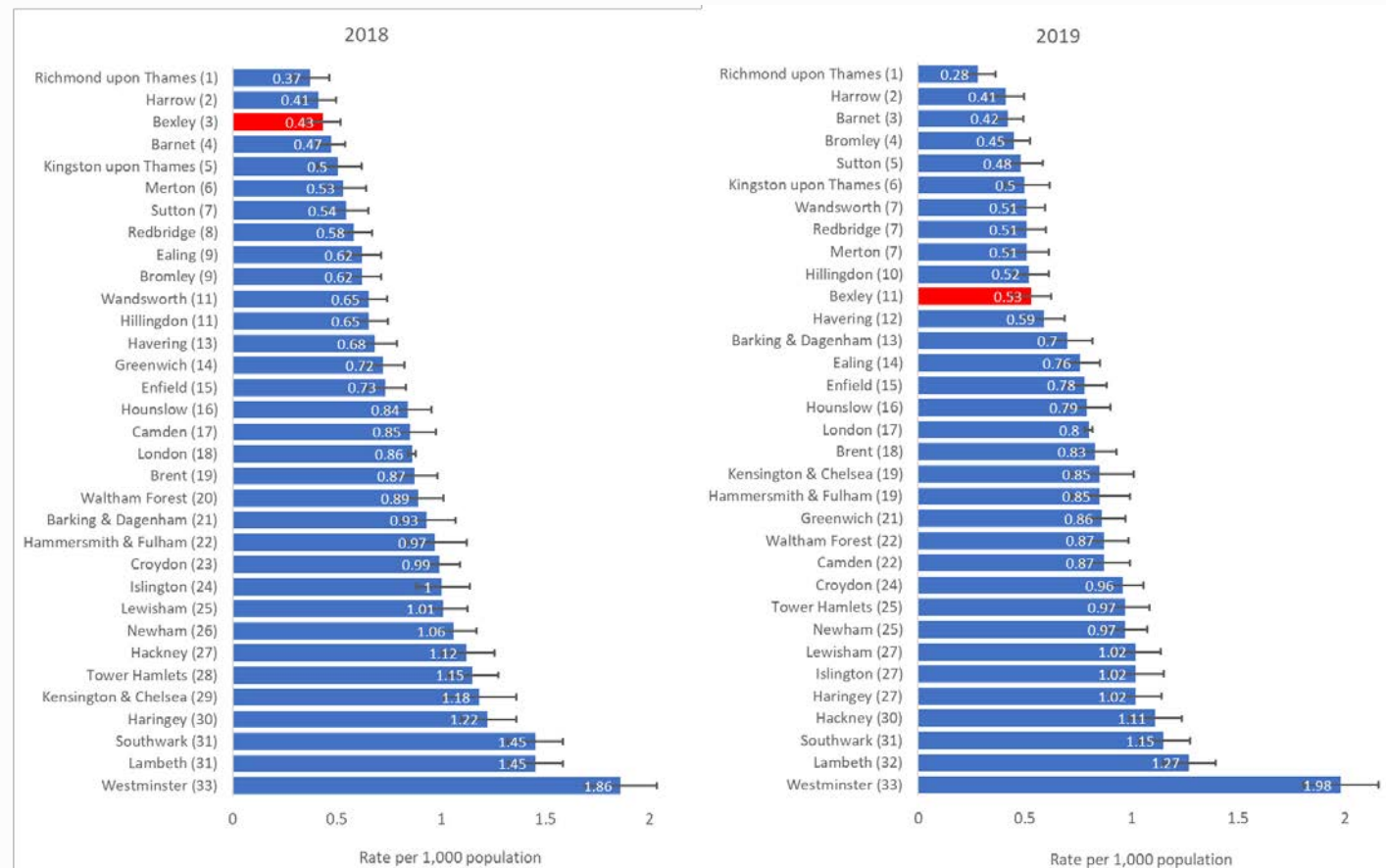

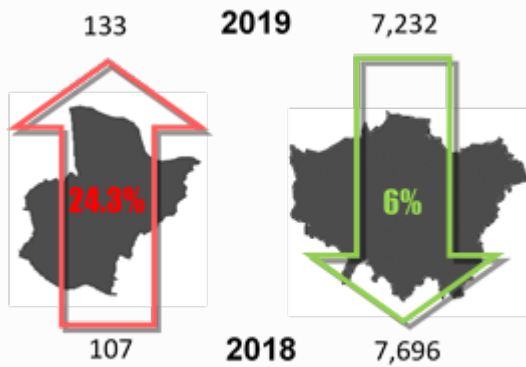

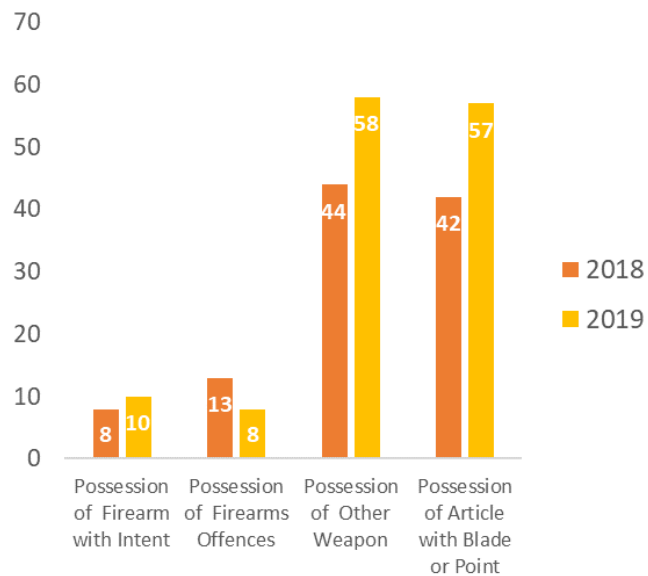
Comparison of Yearly rates for Possession of Weapons, London Boroughs, London



Comparison of Yearly counts for Possession of Weapons, Bexley and London

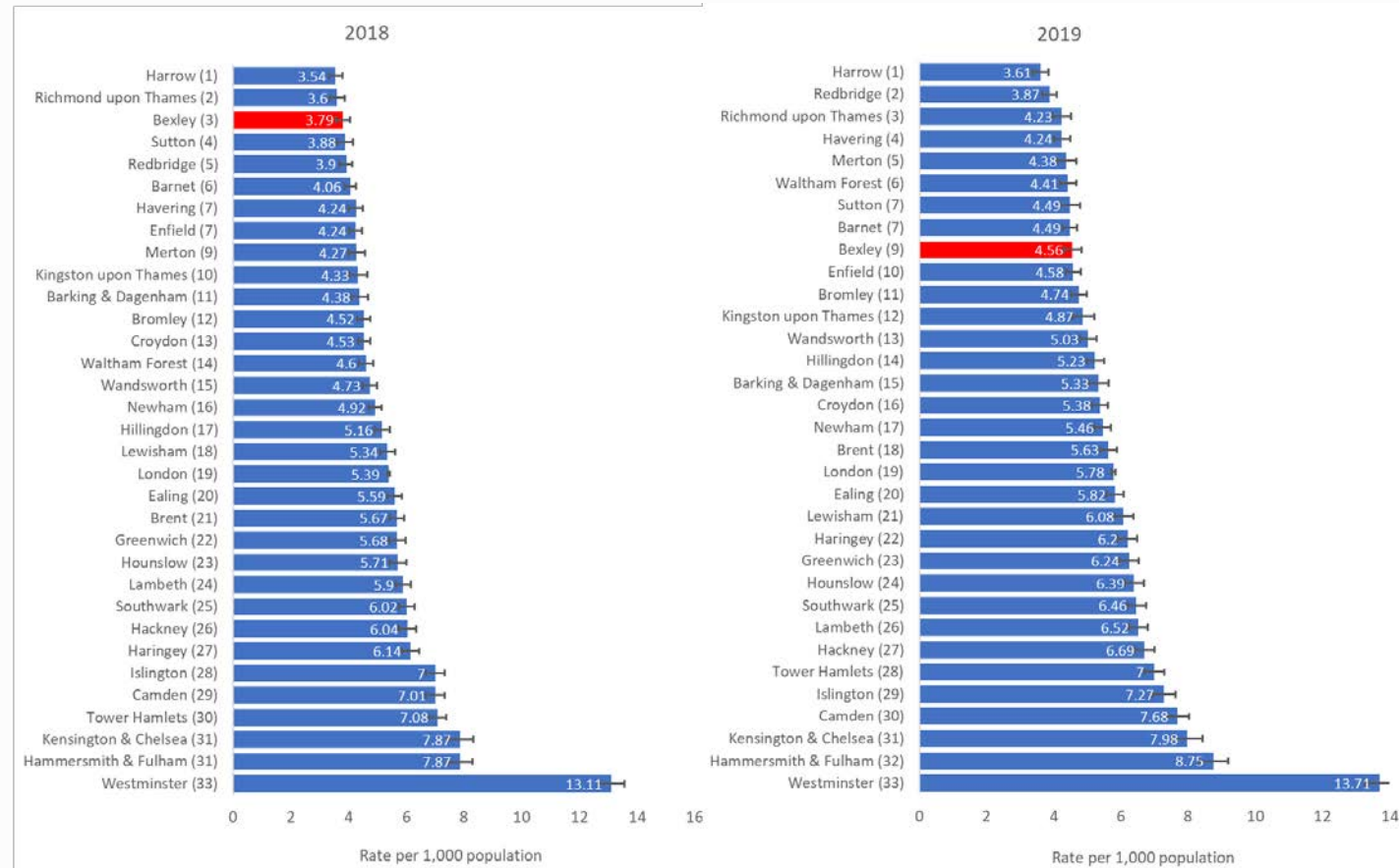


Breakdown of Minor Categories, London Borough of Bexley

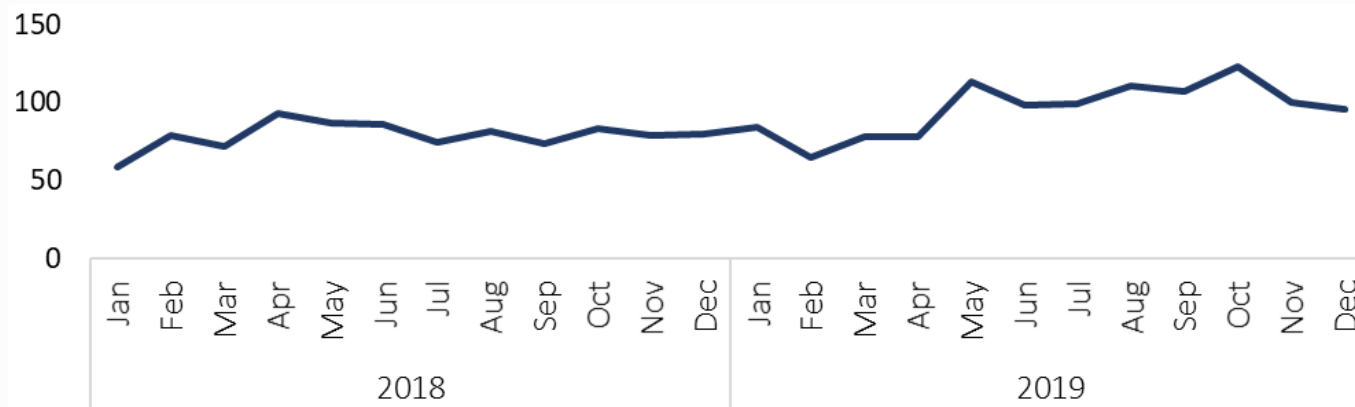

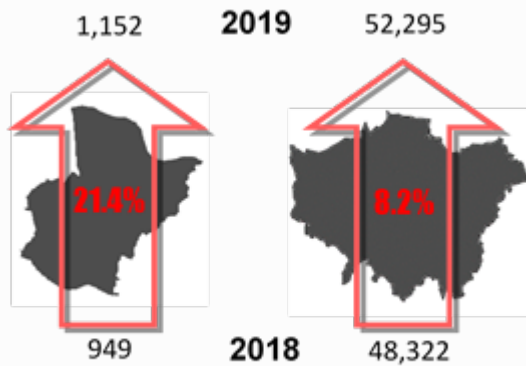
Comparison of Yearly rates for Public Order Offences, London Boroughs, London



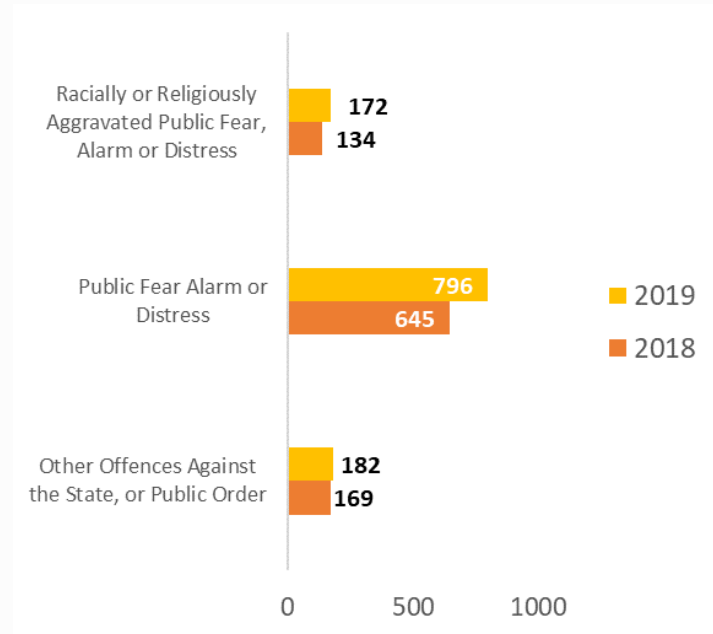
Monthly counts for Public Order Offences, London Borough of Bexley



Comparison of Yearly counts for Public Order Offences, Bexley and London

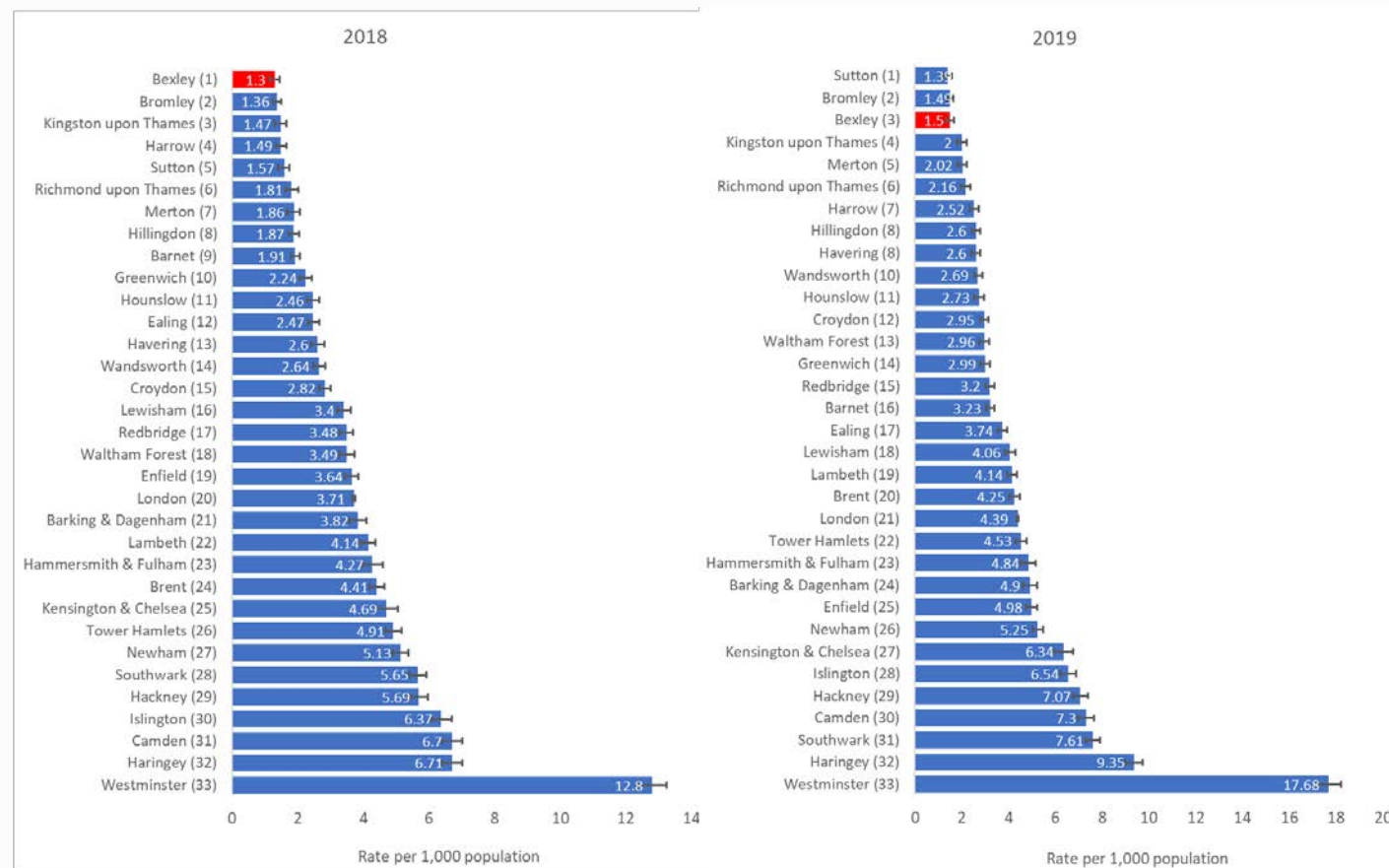


Breakdown of Minor Categories, London Borough of Bexley

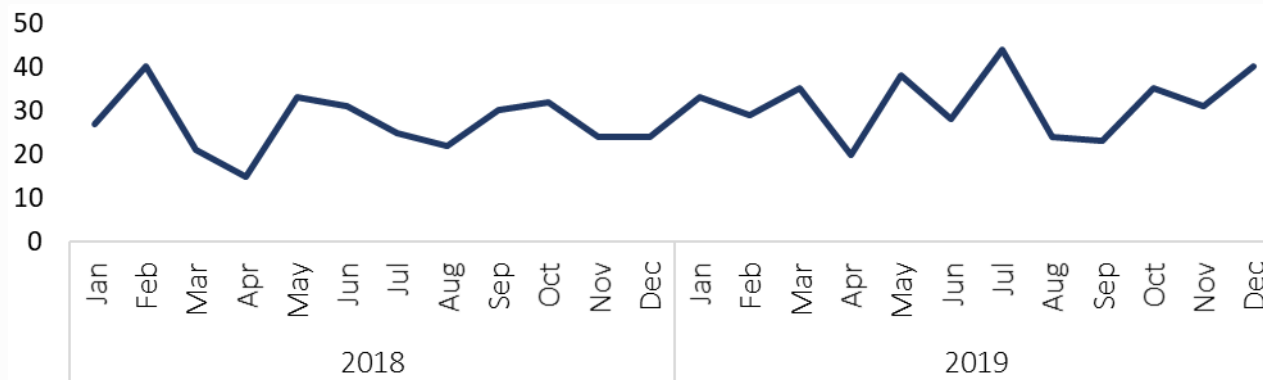

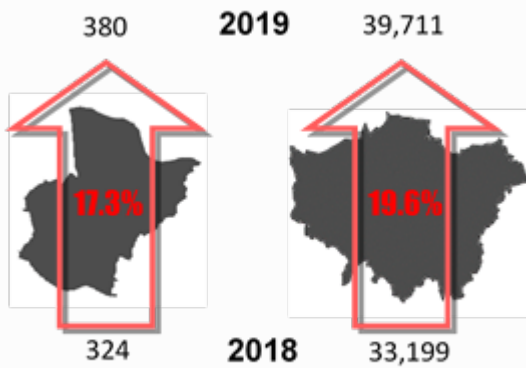
Comparison of Yearly rates for Robbery, London Boroughs, London



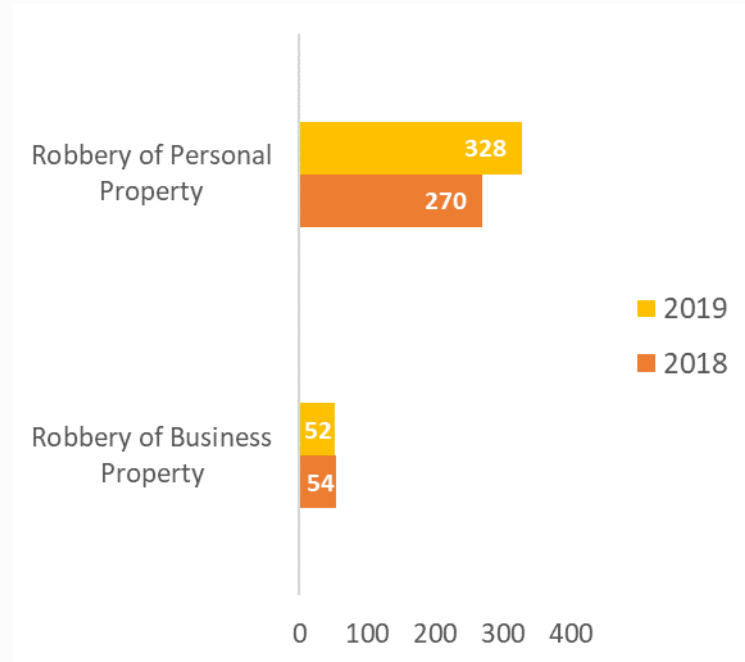
Monthly counts for Robbery, London Borough of Bexley



Comparison of Yearly counts for Robbery, Bexley and London

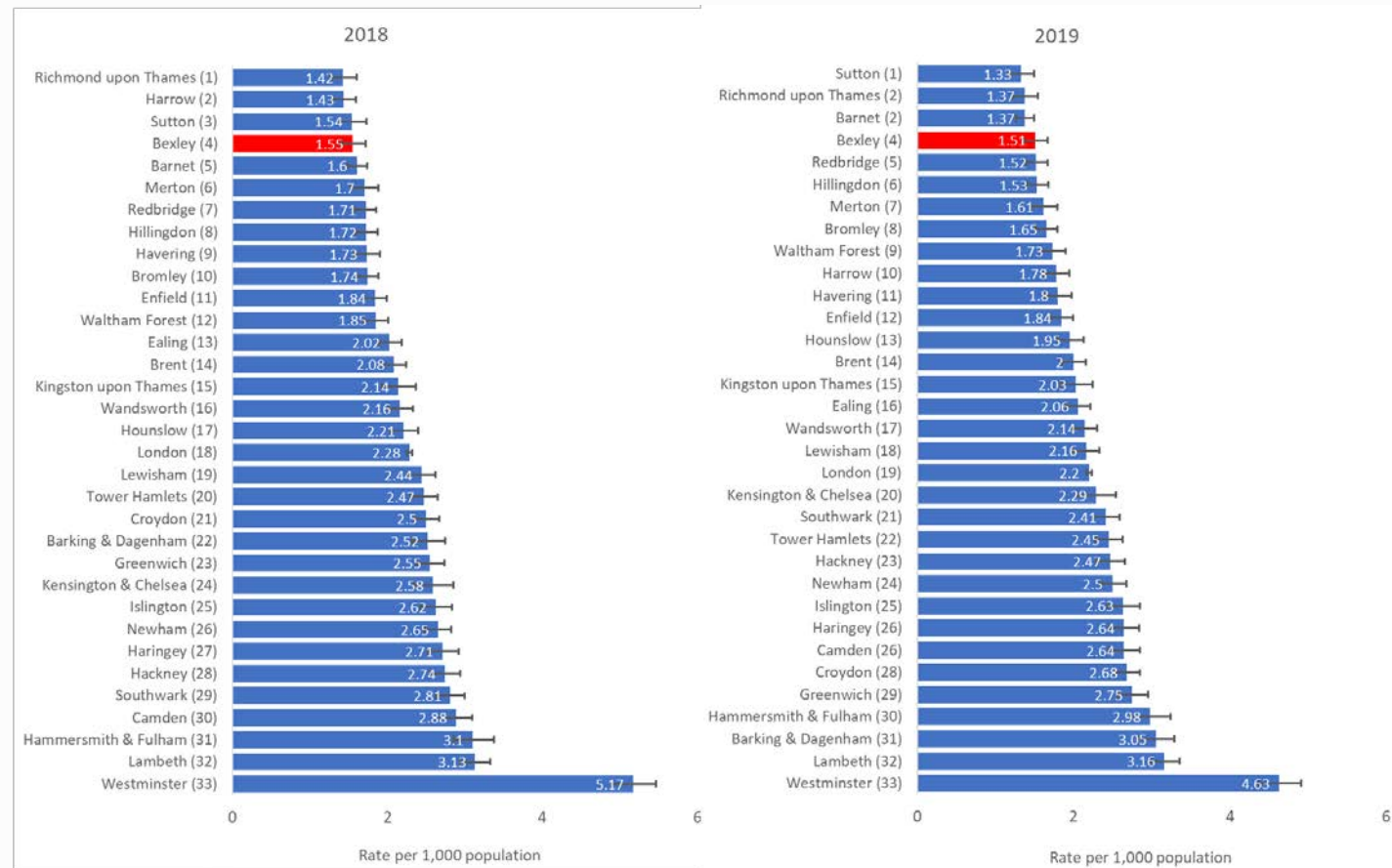

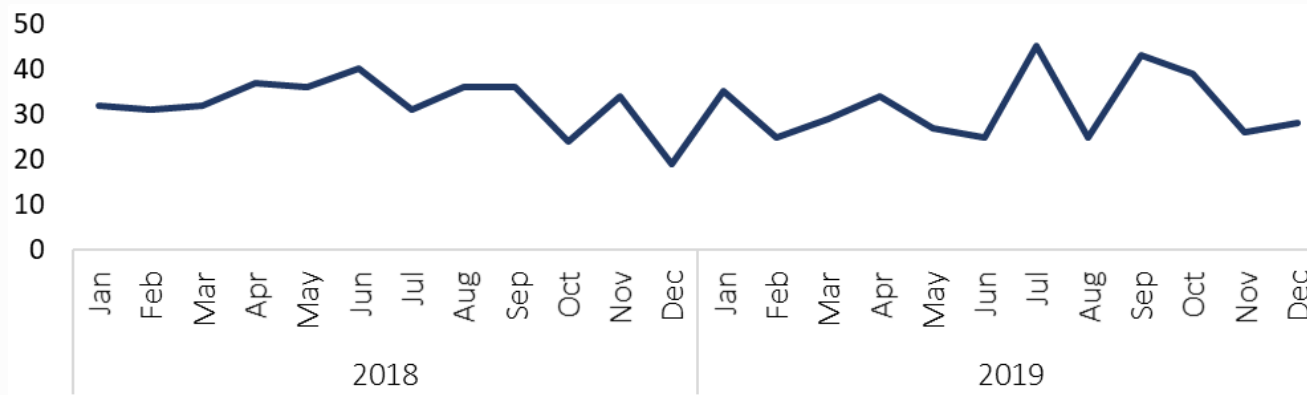

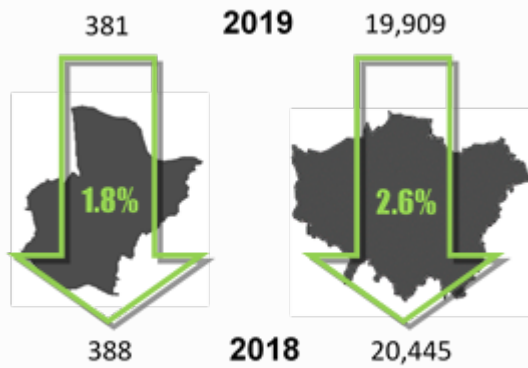
Comparison of Yearly rates for Sexual Offences, London Boroughs, London

Comparison of Yearly counts for Sexual Offences, Bexley and London

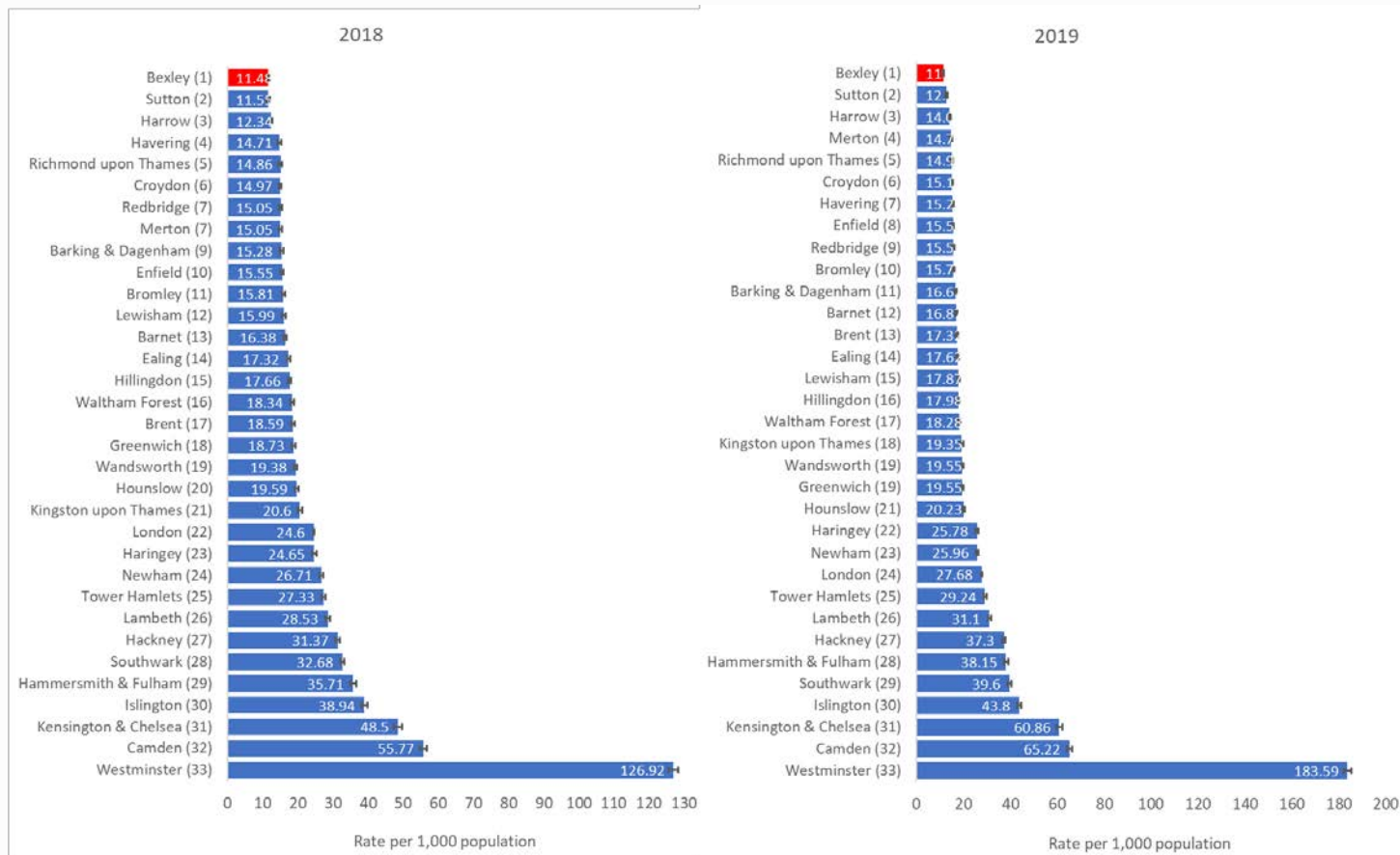


Breakdown of Minor Categories, London Borough of Bexley

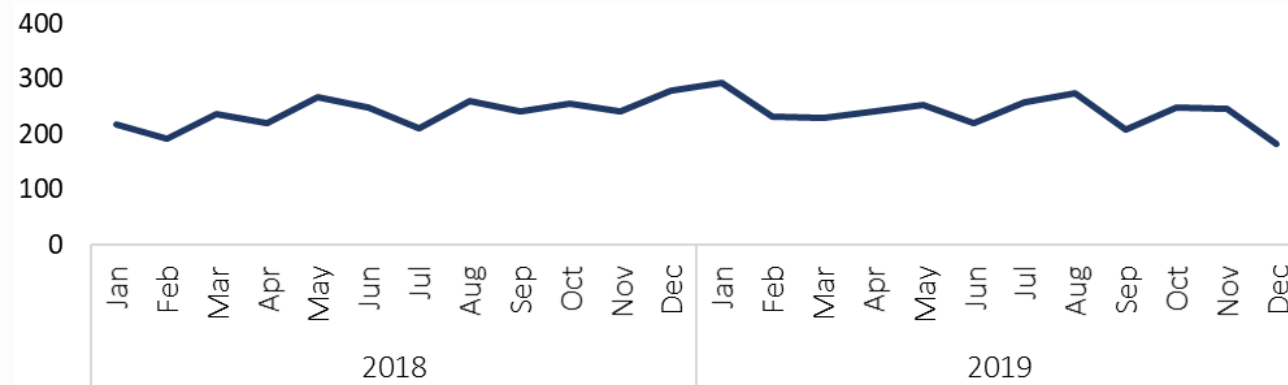

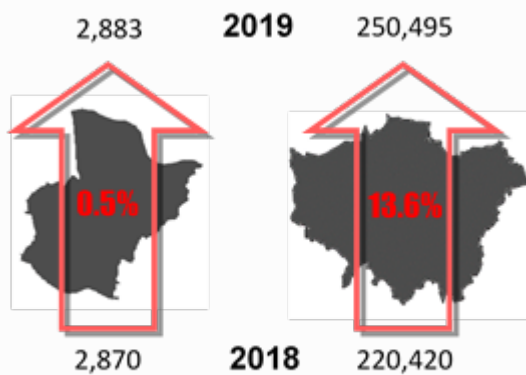
Comparison of Yearly rates for Theft, London Boroughs, London



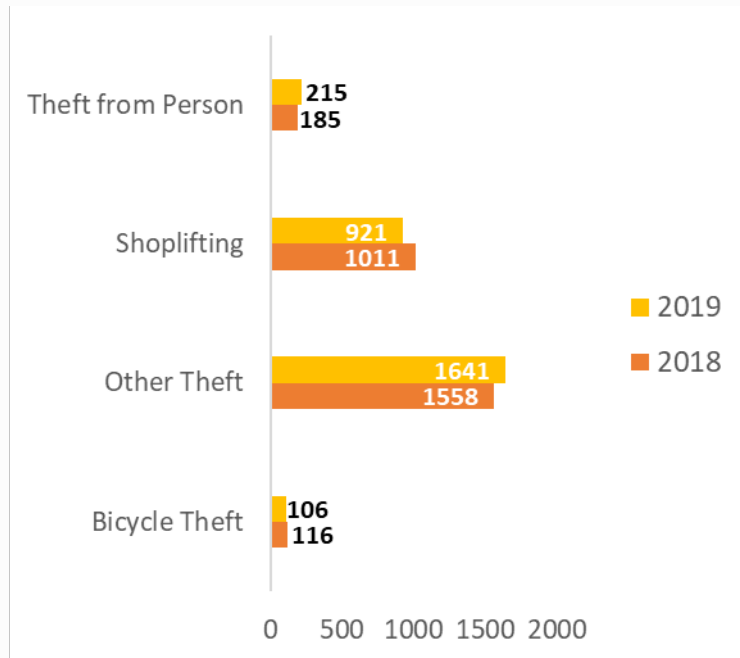
Monthly counts for Theft, London Borough of Bexley



Comparison of Yearly counts for Theft, Bexley and the London

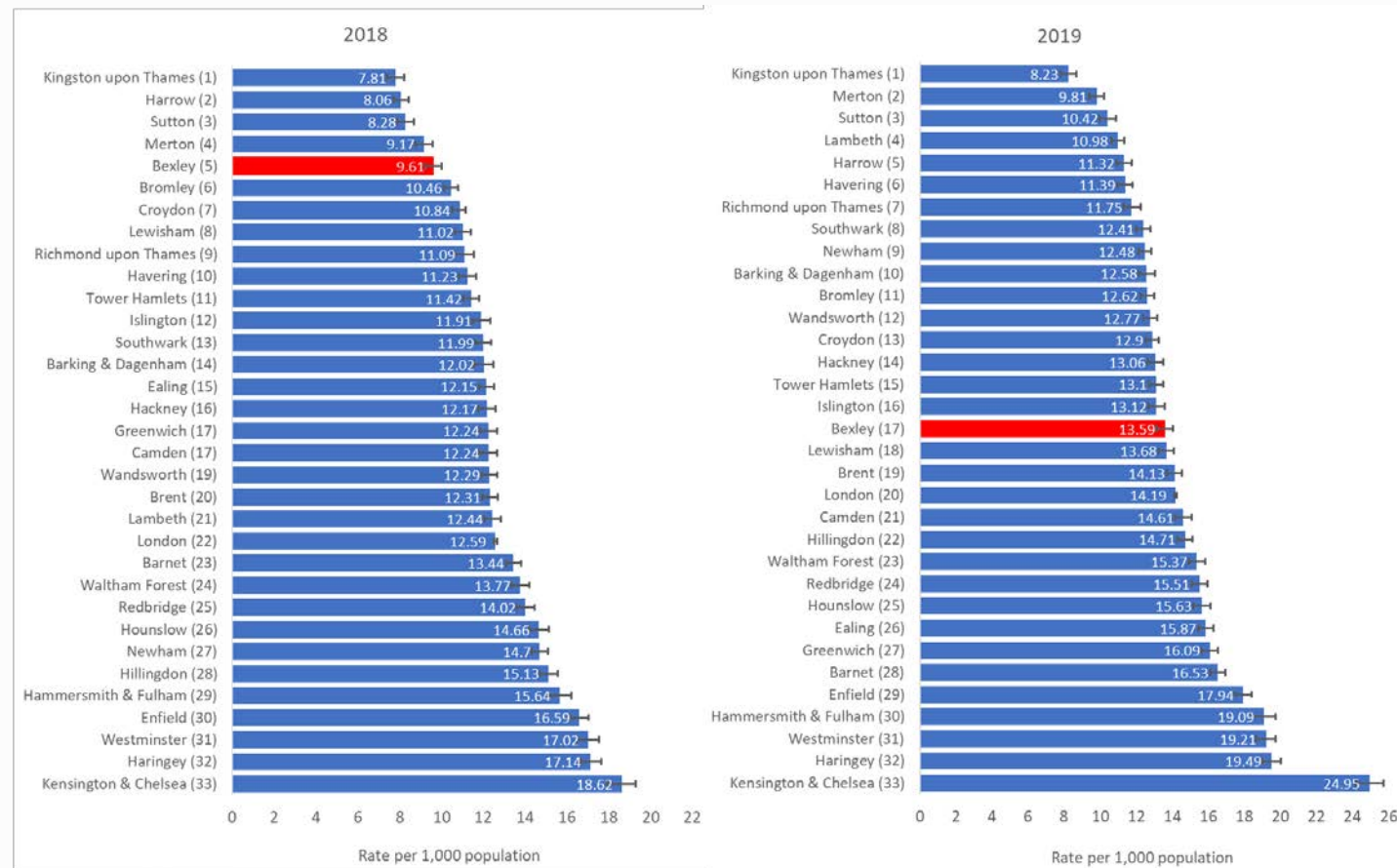

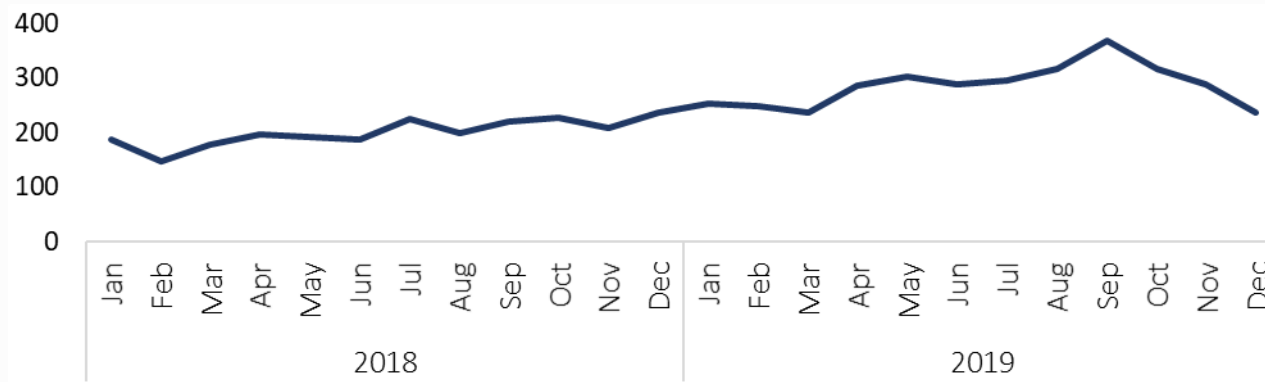

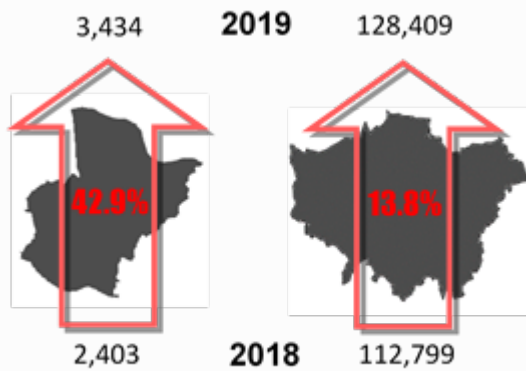
Comparison of Yearly rates for Vehicle Offences, London Boroughs, London



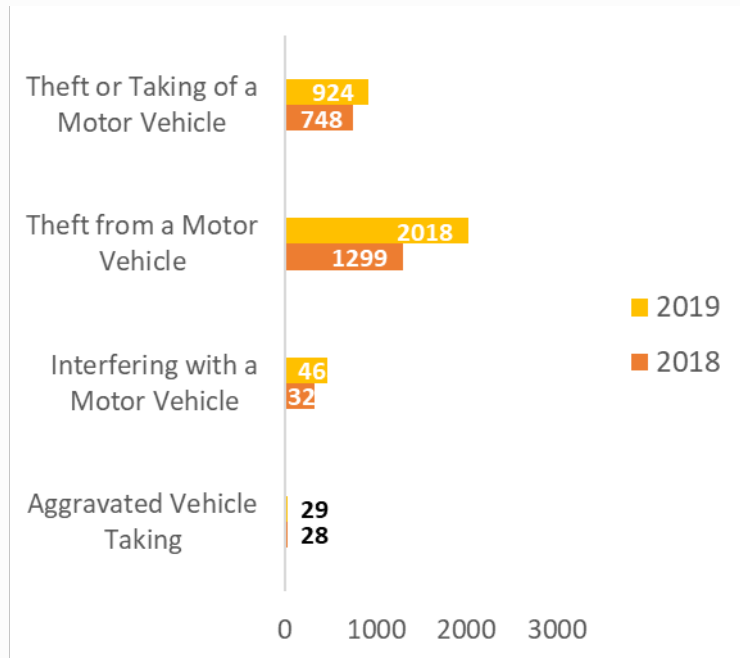
Monthly counts for Vehicle Offences, London Borough of Bexley



Comparison of Yearly counts for Vehicle Offences, Bexley and London

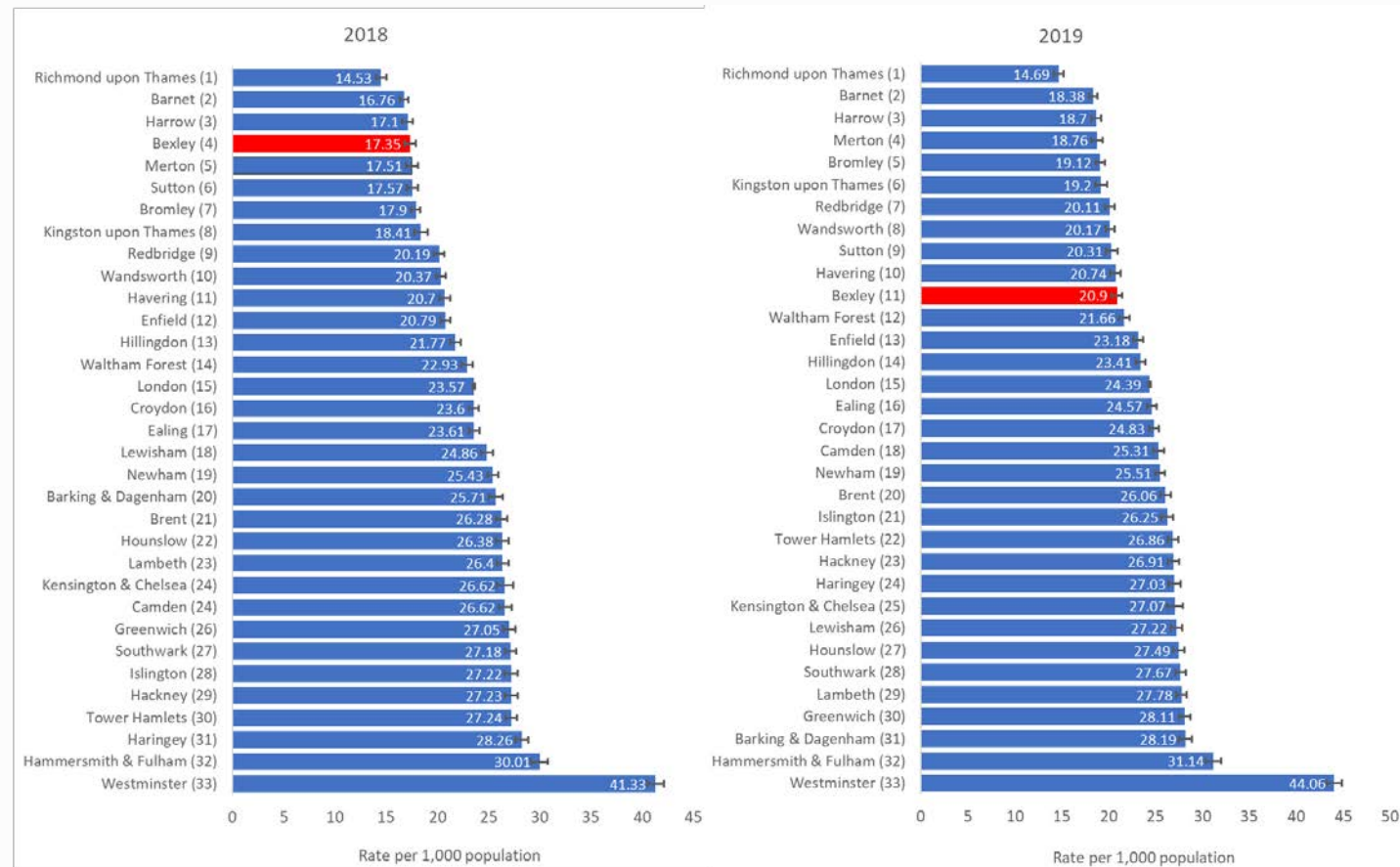

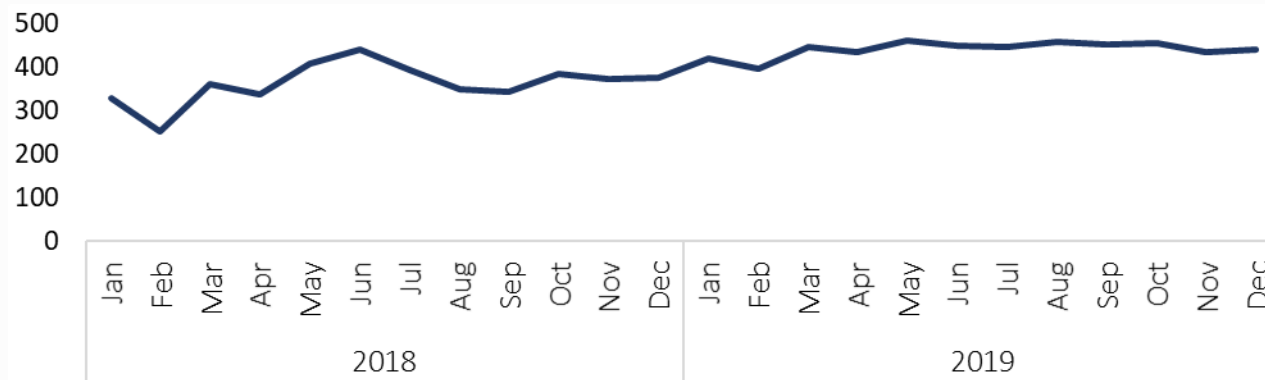

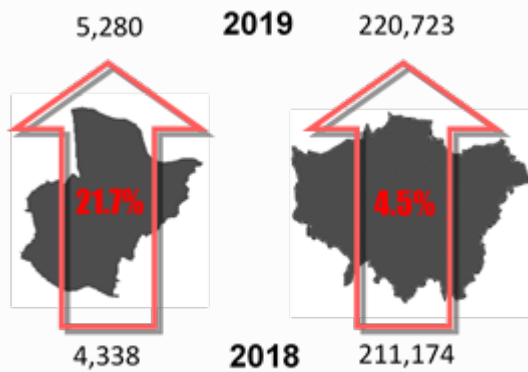
Comparison of Yearly rates for Violence Against the Person, London Boroughs, London



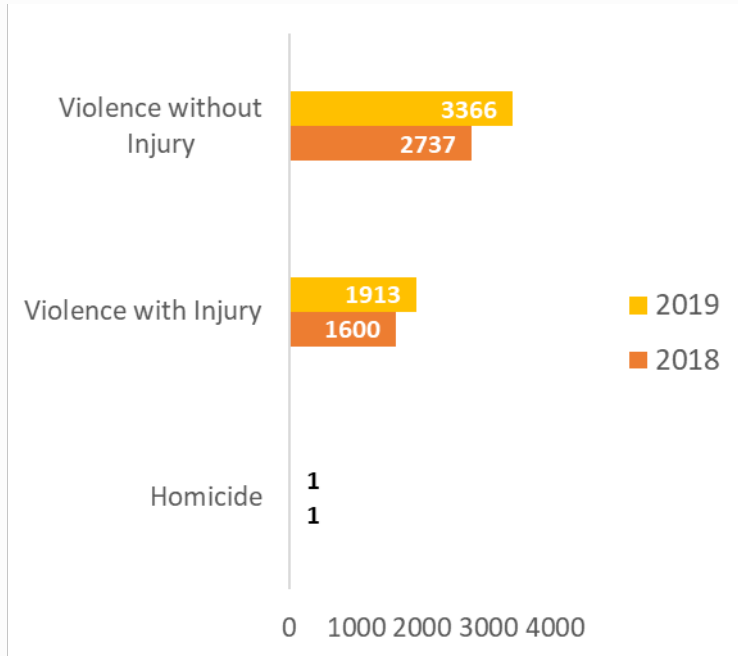
Monthly counts for Violence Against the Person, London Borough of Bexley



Comparison of Yearly counts for Violence Against the Person, Bexley and London

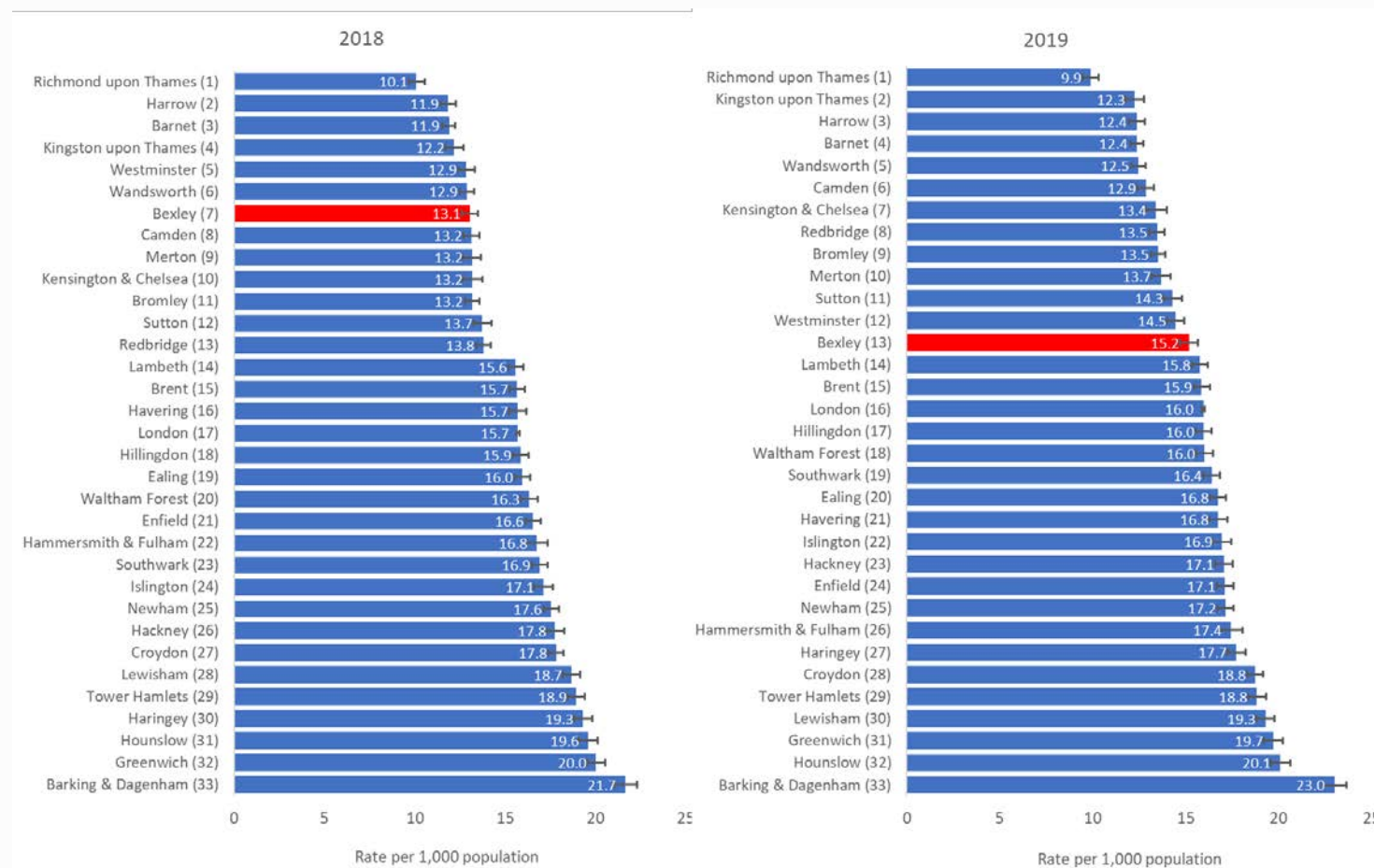


Breakdown of Minor Categories, London Borough of Bexley

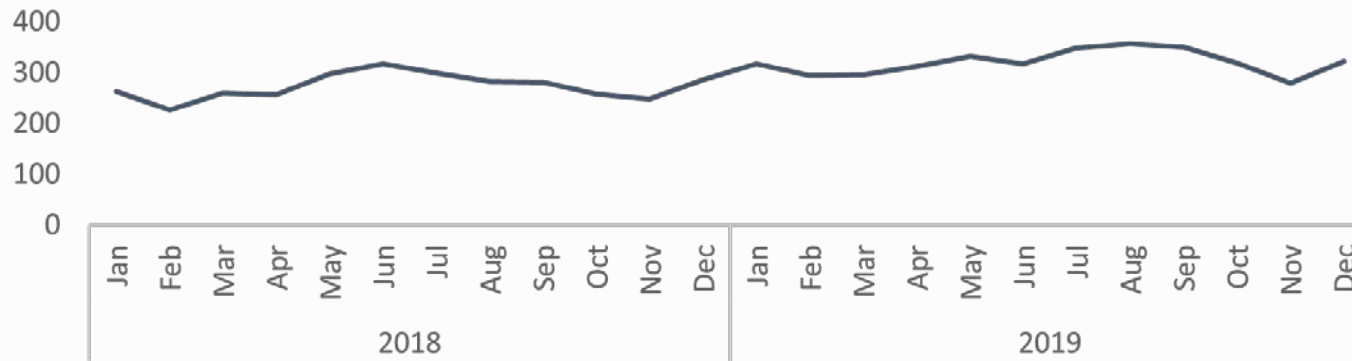

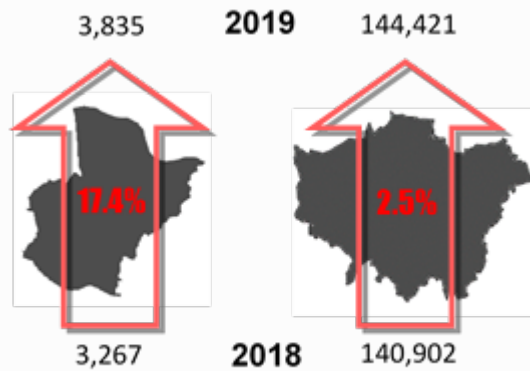
Comparison of Yearly rates for Domestic Abuse Incidents, London Boroughs, London



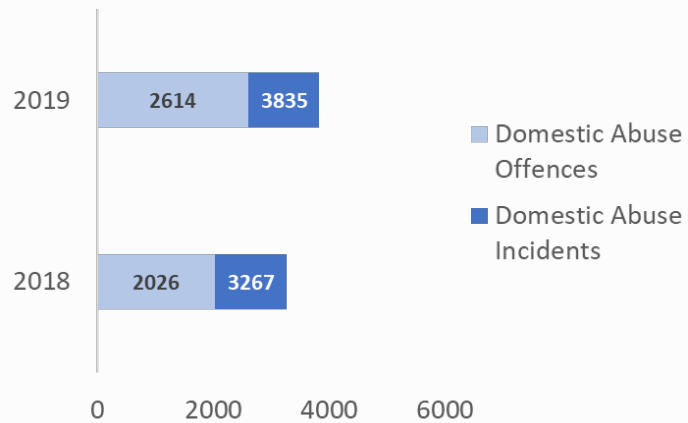
Monthly counts for Domestic Abuse Incidents, London Borough of Bexley

Domestic Abuse Offences as a percentage of Domestic Abuse Incidents, London Borough of Bexley

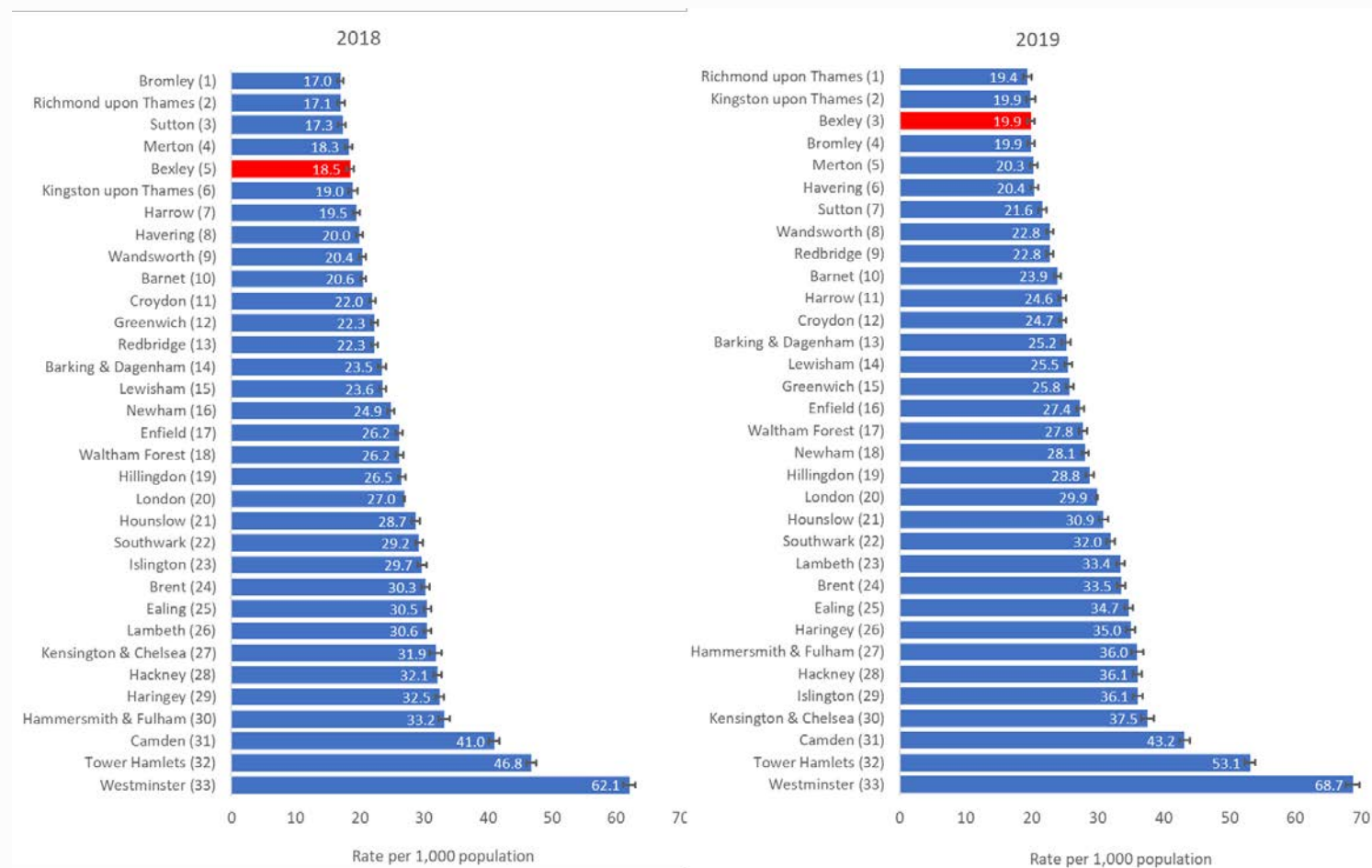

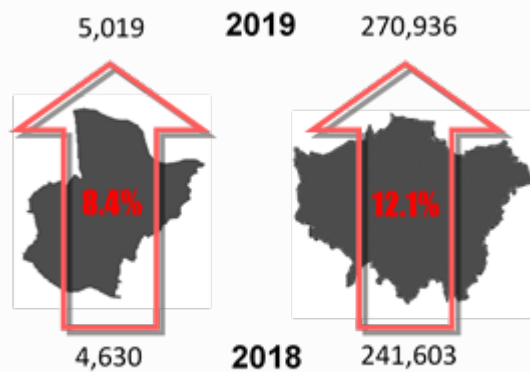
Comparison of Yearly rates for Anti-Social Behaviour Calls, London Boroughs, London



Monthly counts for Anti-Social Behaviour calls, London Borough of Bexley

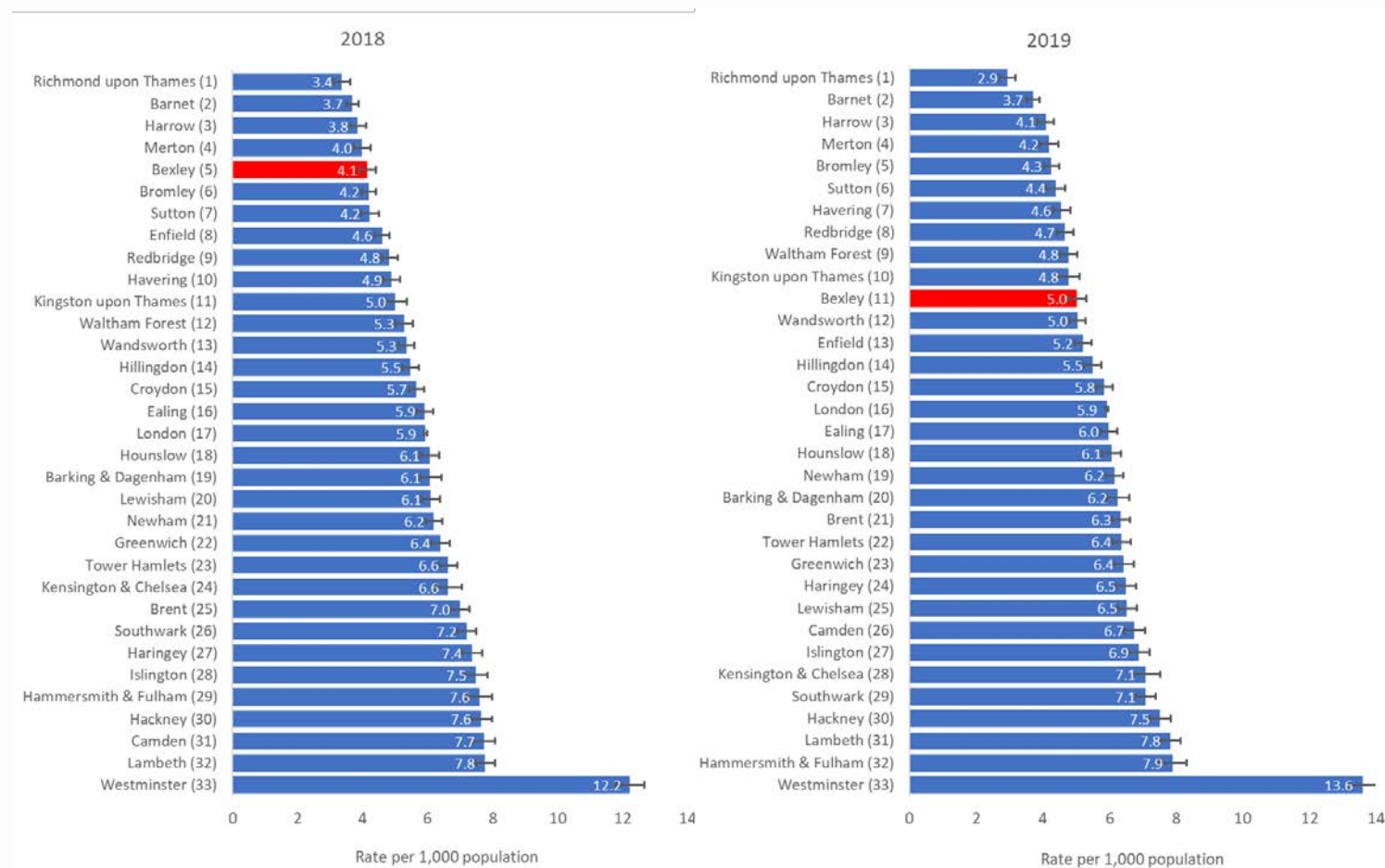


Comparison of Yearly counts for Anti-Social Behaviour calls, Bexley and London

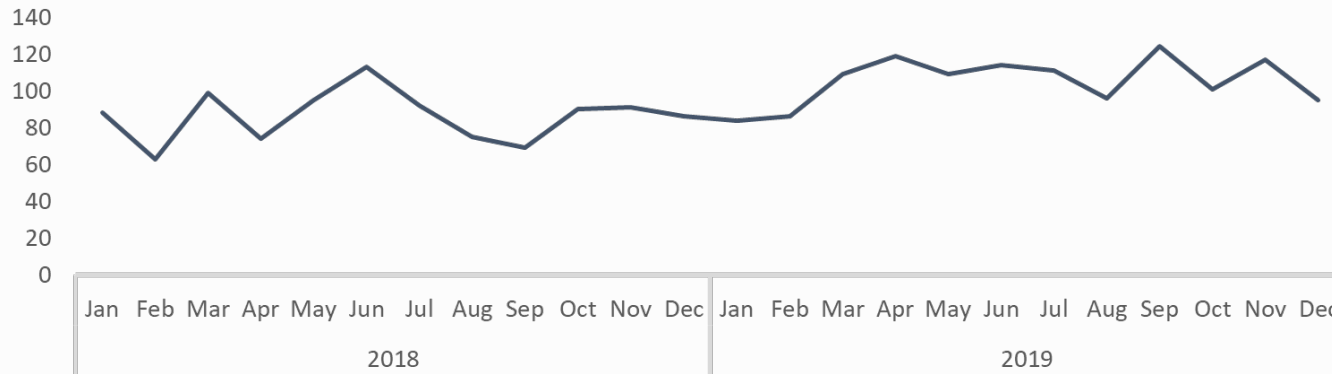

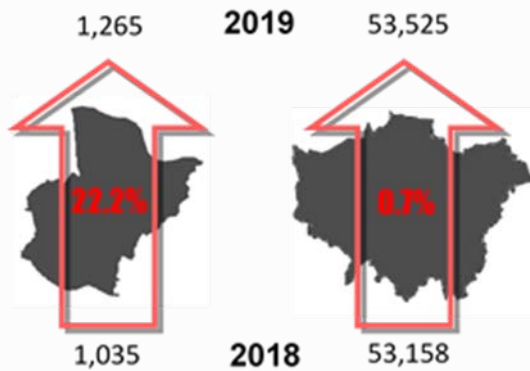
Comparison of Yearly rates for Non-DA VWI, London Boroughs, London

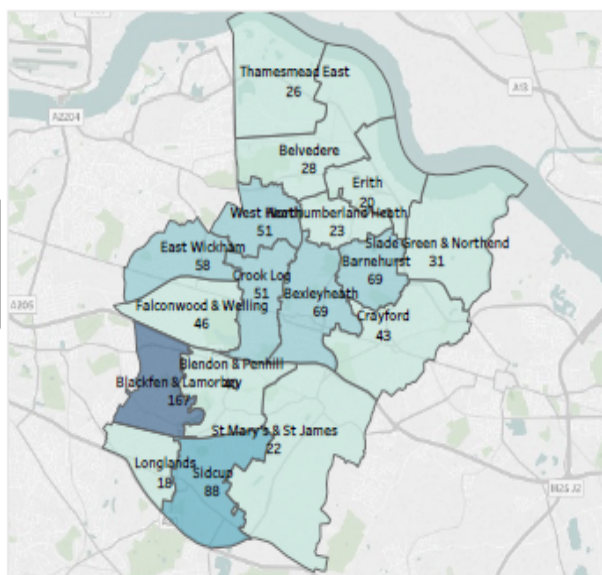
